The data in this report explained

This report predominantly relies on data from <u>willrobotstakemyjob.com</u> (WRTMJ) to evaluate the risk of automation for several occupations. Course pricing information for Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) is taken from IDP's course database, which includes information for over 250,000 courses. Government statistics and data from Australia, the US, Canada and the UK job sites are utilised to evaluate average and median salary data.

Key Findings

Healthcare and Medicine dominate Al-safe careers

Roles such as nurse practitioners, physician assistants, urologists, and rehabilitation physicians consistently rank as the most Al-safe. These careers may be supported by Al in the future, but will always require human empathy, judgment, and care (skills that Al cannot replicate), making them ideal for students seeking secure, high-paying futures abroad.

Postgraduate study can boost career security and salary

Many top Al-safe jobs require further study, especially in medicine and nursing. While postgraduate education adds cost, it significantly increases earning potential, with salaries often exceeding \$200,000 USD in the US.

Undergraduate-only careers still offer strong prospects

Students not pursuing further study can still access AI-safe careers. Roles like physicists, nurse midwives and security managers offer competitive salaries and low automation risk with just a bachelor's degree.

The fastest-growing Al-safe jobs are in Healthcare

Nurse practitioners (46.3% growth), mental health counsellors, and physical therapists are among the fastest-growing roles. These careers are in high demand and offer stability, making them excellent choices for international students.

Degrees in Social Work, Nursing, and Education are highly resilient

The most Al-safe degrees focus on human-centered fields. Social work, paramedical science, occupational therapy, and teaching consistently show low automation risk and strong global demand.

High-risk degrees are linked to routine, process-driven work

Jobs in accounting, clerical support, and data processing face the highest automation risk. Students pursuing these fields should consider adding creative, analytical, or interpersonal skills to remain competitive.

High pay, high growth, Al-safe degrees

Here is a list of 10 jobs that are most resistant to Al. The table shows the relevant study area, whether further study is needed, the cost, the average US salary, the risk of automation, and the expected growth by 2031 for each job.

Jobs that need real human care are the least at risk from Al. Most of these are in Healthcare and Medicine, making them strong options for studying abroad. While many roles require graduate studies, there are also safe choices for students who want to start working right after obtaining a bachelor's degree.

As you can see from the table, studying medicine and nursing pays well. The bonus: risk of automation here is almost zero. Demand is also strong, with physician assistants expected to grow by 28.5% and nurse practitioners by 46.3% by 2031.

High pay, high growth, Al-safe jobs that require Postgraduation degrees

There are well-paying jobs that are safe from AI but require higher studies. Here's the 10 that scored the best.

Even though people worry about AI, these roles remain safe because they need real human care and skills that machines cannot provide. Studying urology, nursing, psychiatry, and immunology abroad in postgraduate studies pays very well. Their average annual salaries are often around \$200,000 in the US, where healthcare wages are a major driver. Nurse practitioners are especially in very high demand, with jobs expected to grow by 46% by 2031.

Studying further can cost more, but in the long run these careers offer strong pay and a secure future.

High pay, high growth, Al-safe jobs that only require an undergraduate degree

What makes these jobs special is that they are resistant to Al and still offer good salaries without needing higher studies. Take a look at the table below to learn more.

Whether you want to care for people's health, pursue science or help keep others safe, there are careers that Al cannot replace. The good news is that an international undergraduate degree in health science, physics, dentistry, mental health nursing, or occupational therapy is enough to get started. For those who don't want to take degree courses, there is also an Al-safe option: first-line supervisors of police and detectives.

People think these jobs have low AI risk (under 34%), pay well, and keep your future secure. They also have strong growth, with physician assistants leading at 28.5% by 2031.

Most Al-safe degrees to study abroad

Around 50 occupations have a risk level of 0% for Al and automation. The top 10 most Alsafe occupations, determined based on user-voted risks, are as follows:

It's not surprising that the most Al-safe jobs and degrees focus on people in Health and Education. These roles need face-to-face care, coaching, and support that technology alone cannot provide.

Many of these jobs come from similar study areas, which means studying Health or Teaching & Education abroad is a smart choice for Al-safe careers. As the table shows, the Al risk for these jobs is below 22%.

The occupations in this table sit among the highest-risk roles for automation. What stands out across them is their shared reliance on routine, process-driven tasks such as administration, record-keeping and clerical support. These functions are precisely the areas where AI and robotics are advancing most quickly, making such jobs particularly vulnerable.

While these examples highlight the more vulnerable end of the job market, the wider degrees connected to them still provide pathways into careers that are more resilient and higher paying.

The table shows that the most Al-safe, highest-paying jobs are in Medicine and Healthcare. Salaries for roles like physical medicine doctors, hospitalists, urologists, and psychiatrists often exceed \$200,000 in the US. The risk of these jobs being replaced by Al is generally low to moderate, mostly below 37%, which means these jobs require human expertise, judgment, and personal care.

Some roles, like physician assistants, pay comparatively less but are growing fast, with a 28.5% increase expected by 2031, showing strong demand and career opportunities for the future.

Occupation	The name of the profession according to WRTMJ data
UG (Undergraduate) study area	A broad field of learning, such as Business, Engineering or Health, that groups related courses and degrees at the bachelor level.
PG (Postgraduate) Study Area	A broad field of learning, such as Business, Engineering or Health, that groups related courses and degrees at the postgraduate level.
Further study needed	Whether generally a degree higher than a bachelor's is required to be qualified for the occupation, as determined by IDP staff using generally available information on the web.
Median US Salary	The middle point of workers' annual earnings in the United States, broken down by occupation, according to the Bureau of Labour Statistics (BLS), taken from WRTMJ data.
Projected growth by 2031	Estimates the change in the number of total people to be employed within that occupation in the US by 2031, according to the BLS, taken from WRTMJ data. A higher percentage means more people are expected to be in that occupation by 2031.
Risk Level	Indicates how vulnerable a given occupation is to being automated based on the abilities, skills, tasks, and activities required in that occupation. A higher score means the occupation is more likely to be automated.
Risk Level Voted	The perceived Risk Level as voted by users of WRTMJ using a Likert scale of Highly likely, Moderate, Uncertain, Low and No chance. It is estimated that a minimum of 10 responses by different users is required to display this metric
Average UG (Undergraduate) degree cost	The average total tuition cost to obtain a bachelor's degree in that study area, taken from course data in Australia, Canada, the UK and the US, displayed in USD.

About the data

Methodology

This report by IDP uses data from 'Will Robots Take My Job' to assess job risk, which is then matched with government wage data for closely related occupations. When salary information was unavailable from government sources, wage data was extrapolated from SEEK, Indeed, and other job-listing platforms.

All course information is taken from IDP's database of over 250,000 courses and converted into USD.

For scoring, all values are normalised (inverse for risks and costs) and weighted (shown below) and then multiplied by 100:

- Risk 30%
- Voted Risk 10%
- Projected growth 25%
- Median Wage 25%
- Study Costs 10%

A 10 point deduction is also applied if further study is required for the occupation.
