

Test Date Flow Chart



1. Arrive the test venue

- The registration period starts from 08:15 to 08:40
- Check your seat number on the candidate name list



2. Check-in your personal items

- Show and turn off your mobile phone in front of the test day staff at the Registration Counter
- Leave personal belongings (including mobile phones, digital watches, etc) at Registration Counter



3. Keep the allowed items with you

- Passport or HKID card (same ID document used for IELTS application)
- Confirmation of Registration (i.e. admission document)
- Water in transparent bottle



4. Before entering to the Test Room

- There is no break between Listening, Reading and Writing and please go to washroom if required
- Having your test day photo and/ or finger scan taken before entering the test room



5. Written test (Listening, Reading and Writing) in the morning

- The test starts at 09:00 and finishes at approximately 12:30
- Collect the personal belongings after end of written test



6. Registration for Speaking Test

- Arrive the speaking registration room at least 20 minutes before your scheduled interview time with your ID card/Passport and interview slip
- Check in and verify your identification.
- Take photos (if required)



7. Allowed items for Speaking Test

- Passport/HKID card
- Interview slip



8. Speaking Test

- You will be taken by the invigilator to the interview room
- Each interview with examiner takes approximately 11-14 minutes



9. After the Speaking Test

- Return the interview slip and collect your personal belongings



10. Test Result

- The Test Report Form is available for collection from 10:30am to 2pm on the 13 calendar days after the test; the provisional result is also available at <https://results.ielts.org> on the same day
