Safe Arrival Program Summary

All international students must complete, before their arrival in Canada:

- a Self-Isolation Plan to satisfy current Canadian government travel restrictions concerning COVID-19, which require travelers arriving in Canada to quarantine for 14 days immediately on their arrival in Canada;
- the Canadian government's ArriveCAN application (available on line); and
- a separate Self-Isolation Plan for BC and Alberta (also available on line),

CHN's Safe Arrival Solutions:

CHN has developed a comprehensive suite of solutions to address the challenges that COVID-19 places on students and educators to safely and lawfully integrate new and returning international students into Canada.

Transportation

CHN has a protocol in place for providing safe transportation between airports and hotels with trusted providers.

Accommodations

CHN is ready to help our students and their parents satisfy the self-isolation requirements based on our CHN "Safe Arrival" protocols. Our hotel quarantine program meets all government requirements. We have arranged for special rates to CHN students.

Meals

CHN's hotel program is full-board, with inexpensive, high-quality dining provided to the student in their room, the cost of the meals are included in the stay.

Supervision

CHN remains available to students 24/7 by phone, chat, text, and email. We have arranged an on-site chaperone for all hotel stay locations with minors present.

Social & Academic Content

CHN has developed a customized curriculum for this unique situation, designed to keep students engaged with light academic and practical learning outcomes, social opportunities with other newly arriving students, and entertained with fun activities.

Visa Advising

CHN has made available to students and agents our ICCRC-licensed immigration consultant to assist with any last-minute hiccups and questions.

Program Detail: Hotel Stay

Stay in a hotel arranged at a discount by CHN, with meals offered in-room. Students will pay hotel directly for their stay using a discount code provided by CHN. *Because Students may be required to complete their Quarantine (Self-Isolation) in one of our Gateway cities only – Montreal; Toronto; Calgary or Vancouver - please separate reservations for international flights to Canada from onward domestic flights in Canada, which must be booked as open tickets with no specific date.*

CHN will:

- Confirm specific hotel details after receipt of application and payment
- Arrange for a chaperone to be on-site 24x7 through duration of stay for any minors in the hotel
- Arrange transportation from airport to hotel and to permanent homestay
- Offer emergency support, 24x7, as usual (with some limitations for intervention to allow social distancing)
- Offer virtual programming during Quarantine period, with other CHN students
- Arrange Keep.meSAFE™ by guard.me counselling service for emotional support

Students must:

- Complete CHN's "Safe Arrival Protocol" documentation in addition to CHN's traditional homestay application and Student Participation Agreement
- After CHN notifies you of which options are available, pay the CHN Fees required
- Communicate all travel plans and changes to plans in a timely fashion with CHN
- Bring art supplies, school materials, and music
