One week compulsory Block Training. Students undertake practical learning and assessment.



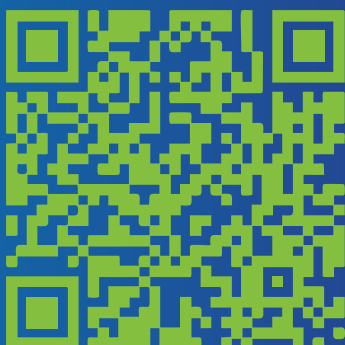
Program ideally suited for
