VETiS Funding	In Queensland VET in School (VETiS) supports certificate II training delivered through general training pathways. This pathway focuses on career paths linked to priority industries and sectors and helps make moving from school to work or further training easier. This training is undertaken as part of your school studies alongside your school curriculum subjects.				
Funding Entitlement	A Student is entitled to one funded VETiS qualification. Once the student has completed a VETiS funded qualification, their funding will be exhausted.				
Funding Eligibility	To access a funded training place under VETiS, a student must:				
	 be enrolled in a Queensland school in Years 10, 11 or 12; not be an international secondary exchange student in Queensland; not be enrolled in a Qualification funded by the Department including a school-based apprenticeship or traineeship not have previously completed a Qualification funded by the Department under VETiS or a similar program by whatever name; and have a genuine interest in pursuing a post-school vocational occupation. 				
Training Arrangement	Students will attend Face to Face training, one day a week at a Connect n Grow Health Hub, located nearest your school. This will be confirmed with you upon enrolment.
