Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

Windstream intends to retire the copper and facilities at all remaining locations in the one (1) exchange listed above. Windstream has or will deploy fiber-to-the-premises network in these areas and intends to provide services on a go forward basis over a fiber network infrastructure. Updating our network from copper to fiber benefits our customers because of fiber's resiliency and reliability, especially in inclement weather. Fiber also provides our customers with expanded capabilities to grow with current bandwidth demands for their home or business.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

After the retirement of the copper facilities, Windstream will: (1) no longer offer any services, including ethernet over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities. To help ensure an orderly transition, Windstream may require customers and interconnecting entities to migrate services off of copper facilities well before the copper retirement implementation date.
