REGISTRATION DEADLINE AND QUALIFICATIONS: The last day to register to vote in this election is July 7, 2026. A person may register to vote at the McNairy County Election Commission during regular office hours. Voters who use "by-mail" forms to register are required to vote in person the first time they vote. Registration by mail forms must be postmarked by July 7, 2026 to be processed for this election. Registrations postmarked after July 7, 2026 will be held and processed after this election. You may also register by going to www.govotetn.gov.

ADDRESS OR NAME CHANGE DEADLINE: Voters who are already registered to vote in McNairy County may change their address or name by sending their old registration card with the corrections; or by sending a note requesting said change with their signature; or, by coming to the Election Commission Office by August 1, 2026 and make change; or, by making the change while casting your vote during early voting. You may also make changes by going to www.govotetn.gov. Federal law mandates that a person must vote in the precinct of their residence. It is the voter's responsibility to notify the Election Commission Office when they move, to avoid numerous problems on election day.

Voters qualified to vote in the Eastview Town Election, Enville Town Election or Michie Town Election must reside in said town.

The McNairy County Election Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability. If there are questions about needed accommodations in the voting process, please contact the Election Office.
