She Hygiene is our social initiatives that aims to fulfill the need of underprivileged menstruating females by providing them with eco-friendly sanitary pads on a monthly basis.

We planted about 71 trees this month as part of S4SF, and we also helped clean up the Yamuna at the ITO Delhi side. For a green celebration of our hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday, the "We Rise Together" team planted trees. Yet again, "The We Rise Together team" is committed to promoting climate justice via the planting of trees and cleaning of waterways.



SHE HYGIENE

The We Rise Together foundation held two She Hygiene drives in September, during which we gave out about 450 sanitary pads to girls who were less privileged. We are working together to help these girls who are less fortunate with their issues with menstrual hygiene, and we do this by giving them access to products like sanitary pads, menstrual cups, and other related items. Breaking the stigma surrounding menstruation hygiene and spreading awareness of it are two things we work on constantly.



MY FIRST PERIOD

We had an enlightening conversation with Ms. Swati Bedekar in the final episode of My First Period. Ms. Swati is the founder of the Sakhi Project, a path breaking initiative of setting up low cost Organic Sanitary Pad manufacturing units for underprivileged ladies. 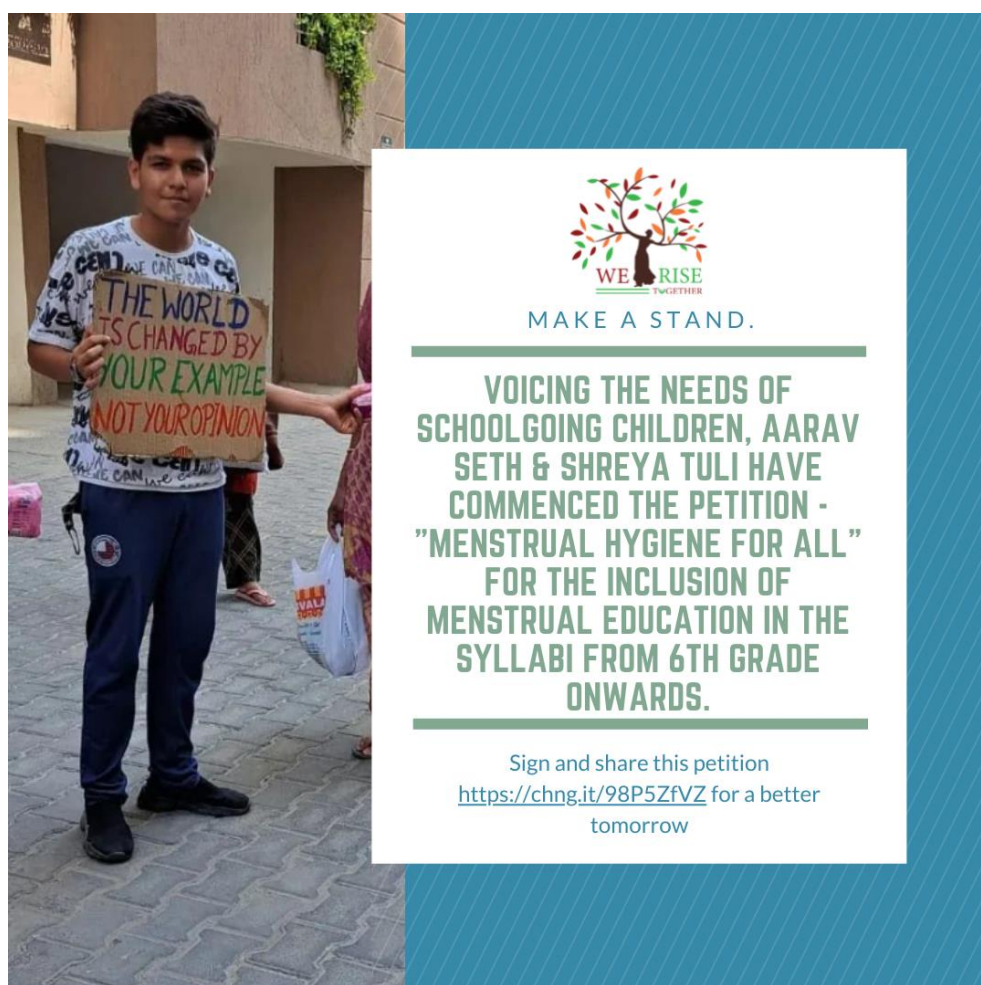
