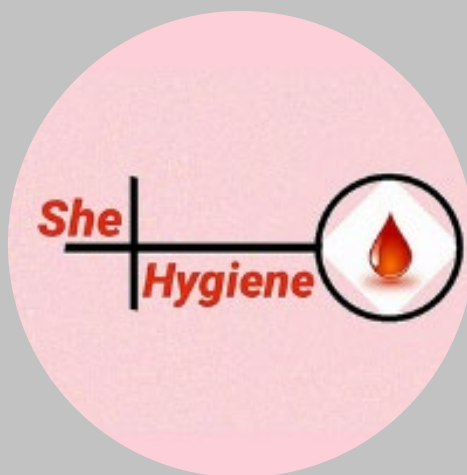

HELPING HANDS

SHE HYGIENE

She Hygiene is our social initiatives that aims to fulfill the need of underprivileged menstruating females by providing them with eco-friendly sanitary pads on a monthly basis.

SUNDAY4SECURED FUTURE

We planted 60 plants, including some fruit trees, over the course of four drives. We also cared for the earlier-planted plants by watering them. Many more people have been inspired to join us in preserving the environment as a consequence of our initiatives.



SHE HYGIENE

We provided 157 girls with biodegradable sanitary pads throughout the month of March and raised their understanding of menstrual hygiene. We also taught underprivileged girls about proper menstruation hygiene. Additionally, we worked with Ms. Jaya Parekh, the Principal of Ram Ratna International School, to provide sanitary pads to a tribal school in Maharashtra. There, girls also received education on menstrual hygiene and health.
