

**AGREED RECORD OF CONCLUSIONS OF FISHERIES CONSULTATIONS
BETWEEN ICELAND AND THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY ON
REGULATION EC 1005/2008 TO PREVENT, DETER AND ELIMINATE
ILLEGAL, UNREPORTED AND UNREGULATED FISHING
BRUSSELS, 24 NOVEMBER 2009**

1. A Community Delegation headed by Mr Fokion Fotiadis and a Icelandic Delegation headed by Stefán Haukur Jóhannesson met in Brussels on 24 November 2009 to consult about the implementation of Regulation EC 1005/2008 of 29 September 2008 establishing a Community system to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing (IUU fishing) published in the Official Journal of the European Union L286 of 29 October 2008 (the IUU Regulation).
2. The heads of Delegations agreed to recommend to their respective authorities the administrative arrangements as outlined in this Agreed Record, including Annex I.
3. The Delegations reiterated their determination to cooperate, in their mutual interest, in securing continued responsible fisheries and ensuring the long term conservation of sustainable exploitation of living aquatic resources for which they are responsible for and the cooperation in the fight against IUU fishing.
4. The Delegations agreed to meet upon request to adjust, if necessary, the arrangements set out in this Agreed Record.


5. CATCH CERTIFICATION SCHEME

5.1 In accordance with Article 12(4) of the IUU Regulation, the catch certificate provided for in Article 12 and Annex II of the IUU Regulation will, as of 1 January 2010 be replaced - for fisheries products obtained from catches made by fishing vessels flying the Icelandic flag - by the Icelandic catch certificate, based on the Icelandic System on weighing and recording of catches, which is an electronic traceability system under the control of the Icelandic authorities ensuring the same level of control by authorities as required under the Community catch certification scheme.

A specimen of the Icelandic catch certificate is given in Annex I.

5.2 Documents referred to in Article 14(1) and (2) of the IUU Regulation may be communicated by electronic means.

5.3 Iceland will require a catch certificate for landings and imports to Iceland of catches made by fishing vessels flying the flag of a Member State of the European Community.




6. MUTUAL ASSISTANCE

6.1 The Delegations agreed to develop mutual assistance under Article 51 of the IUU Regulation to facilitate the exchange of information and the assistance between their respective authorities.

6.2 Detailed rules on mutual assistance are laid down in the regulation implementing the IUU Regulation.

This Agreed Record will be implemented within the European Community legal order via the implementing regulation to Council Regulation 1005/2008. Iceland will also implement the arrangements set out in this Agreed Record by issuing a Regulation.


