Subject: Icelandic Transport Authority Part-21 Subpart F and G policy

The Icelandic Transport Authority (ICETRA) would like to inform the aviation community in Iceland of its policy regarding Part-21 Subpart F^1 and Subpart G^2 activities of the potential organisation applying for said approvals with a principal place of business in Iceland.

In Iceland, there has not been any organisation manufacturing products, parts or appliances under (EU) Regulation 748/2012 (Part-21), and this is not foreseen in the near future. Therefore, ICETRA has not developed the necessary procedures, trained staff, etc., to oversee such activities. At the current state, ICETRA does not have the capability.

If so required, it is ICETRA policy to request EASA to take on the responsibility of approval and oversight of organisation manufacturing products, parts or appliances under Part-21 Subpart F and G. This provision is stated in Article 20 in Basic Regulation³ and Article 64(1) of New Basic Regulation (NBR)⁴.

The NBR Article 64(2) also allows ICETRA to relocate the responsibility to another Member State upon request.

When the need arises, ICETRA will assess the options. Therefore, an applicant needs to consider this in their initial approval plan.
