



# National Childhood Vaccination Program in Iceland as of January 2025

## Age: Vaccination against:

During pregnancy	Pertussis (Boostrix, given to a mother who is approx. 28 weeks pregnant)	
6 weeks	Rotavirus (oral drops; RotaTeq)	
3 months	Rotavirus (oral drops; RotaTeq), DTaP-Hib-Polio (Pentavac) and PCV (Vaxneuvance)	
5 months	Rotavirus (oral drops; RotaTeq), DTaP-Hib-Polio (Pentavac) and PCV (Vaxneuvance)	
12 months	DTaP-Hib-Polio (Pentavac), PCV (Vaxneuvance) and menACWY (MenQuadfi)	6–59 months: Seasonal influenza vaccination in the fall
18 months	MMR and VZV (ProQuad)	
2,5 years	VZV (Varilrix)	
4 years	DTaP (Boostrix)	
12 years	MMR (M-M-RVAXPRO) HPV (Gardasil 9; all genders)	
14 years	DTaP-Polio (Repevax)
