## AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF SAFE PRACTICE FOR CARGO STOWAGE AND SECURING(CSS CODE)

Annex12- Safe stowage and securing of unit loads

In section 2 "Cargo information", in subparagraph .3, the word "and" is deleted, in subparagraph.4, "."is replaced by the word"; and the following new subparagraph.5 is added:

".5 relevant examination certificates for per-slings around cargo units. The slings should be identified by specific means, e.g. colour coding, batch numbers or otherwise."
