ASSISTED VOLUNTARY RETURN AND REINTEGRATION FROM ICELAND

The Organization International for Migration (IOM) is implementing an assisted reintegration voluntary return and (AVRR) with The Icelandic programme together of Immigration (UTL) that Directorate provides assistance for persons who want to return voluntarily from Iceland to their country of origin.

In addition to travel arrangements, beneficiaries can receive post-arrival reintegration support ranging from EUR 1,200 in cash to EUR 4,200 in in-kind support per adult. Amount of support depends on the return country and on chosen form the of reintegration support.

With in-kind support small part of the grant is paid cash and major part in in or commodities by local IOM services office. Suitable targets for using in-kind be paying housing, support can e.g. for health tuition fees, care services or a business. starting

Beneficiaries of IOM's AVRR assistance include stranded migrants, irregular migrants, asylum seekers who decide not to pursue their claims or who are found not be to need of international protection. AVRR in assistance can also be provided to migrants in vulnerable situations, such as trafficking, unaccompanied victims of and separated children. or migrants with healthrelated needs.
