

ASSISTED VOLUNTARY RETURN AND REINTEGRATION FROM ICELAND

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) is implementing an assisted voluntary return and reintegration (AVRR) programme together with The Icelandic Directorate of Immigration (UTL) that provides assistance for persons who want to return voluntarily from Iceland to their country of origin.

In addition to travel arrangements, beneficiaries can receive post-arrival reintegration support ranging from EUR 1,200 in cash to EUR 4,200 in in-kind support per adult. Amount of support depends on the return country and on the chosen form of reintegration support.

With in-kind support small part of the grant is paid in cash and major part in services or commodities by local IOM office. Suitable targets for using in-kind support can be e.g. paying for housing, tuition fees, health care services or starting a business.

Beneficiaries of IOM's AVRR assistance include stranded migrants, irregular migrants, asylum seekers who decide not to pursue their claims or who are found not to be in need of international protection. AVRR assistance can also be provided to migrants in vulnerable situations, such as victims of trafficking, unaccompanied and separated children, or migrants with health-related needs.
