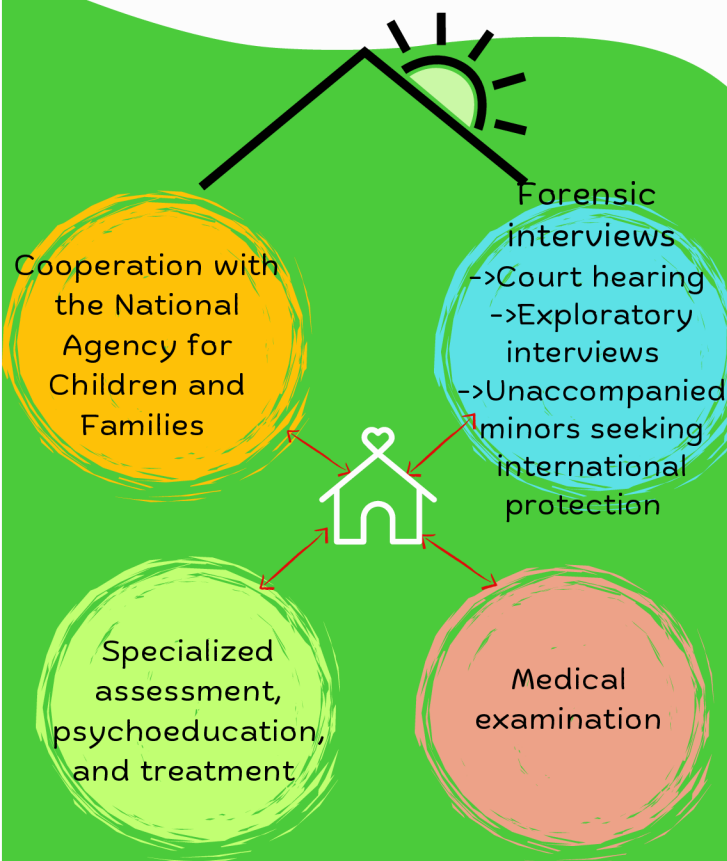


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ABOUT BARNAHÚS

Barnahús handles the issues of children and adolescents who are suspected of having been victims of or witnessed violence.

Barnahús has been in operation since 1998. The goal of Barnahús is to provide specialized services from different professionals under one roof, in a child-friendly environment.



FORENSIC INTERVIEWS

Specialists from Barnahús talk to children and adolescents on their own terms.

The aim is to help the child talk about what has happened, in a safe and warm environment.

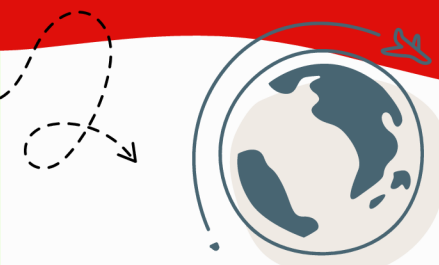
COURT HEARING

Courts may request that the hearing be held in Barnahús if the child is under 15 years of age. Specialists from Barnahús usually conduct the interview, under the supervision of a judge.

Adolescents between the ages of 15 and 18 go to the police for a hearing, except in exceptional cases

EXPLORATORY INTERVIEW

Carried out at the request of child protective services when the case does not involve police investigation.



UNACCOMPANIED MINORS SEEKING INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION

Child protective services, in consultation with the Directorate of Immigration, may request an exploratory interview for unaccompanied minors seeking international protection.



MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Medical examinations may take place at Barnahús and will be conducted by doctors and a nurse.
