***1 Approval of the aviation security plan of foreign carriers.**

An operator with a certificate issued by a foreign country that flies scheduled flights between Iceland and a foreign country shall submit its aviation security programme to the Icelandic Transport Authority before the flight begins.

An operator with a certificate issued by a foreign country that flies irregular flights between Iceland and a foreign country, more than four flights over a period of two months, must also submit its aviation security programme to the Icelandic Transport Authority, in good time, for scheduled flights.
