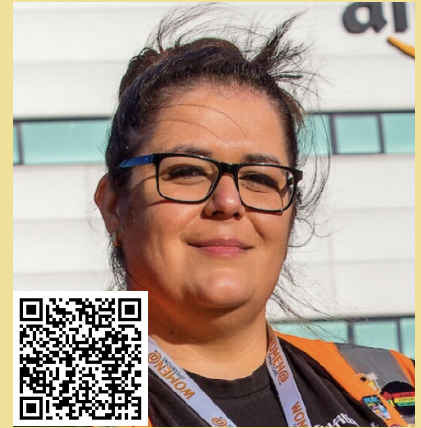

SUPPLY CHAIN WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE LEVEL 2

AS A WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE, YOUR DAY TO DAY TASKS MIGHT INVOLVE:

- ▶ Picking and packing products for customers
- ▶ Moving products around the warehouse facility
- ▶ Using assisted technology and manual handling (MHE), which you will be trained on
- ▶ Using IT systems to keep accurate records of products
- ▶ Health and Safety - following rules and guidelines to keep yourself and your colleagues safe while working

AFTER COMPLETION, YOU MAY MOVE ON TO:

- ▶ Level 3 Transport and Warehouse Operations Supervisor apprenticeship or Team leader and Technical Operations Departmental Manager and then possibly to Level 6 Chartered Management.
