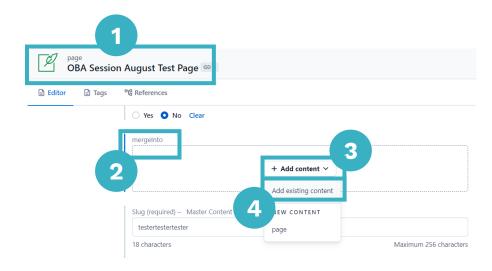

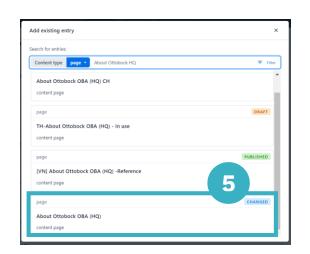

Merging will give you immediate access to updated or new content when HQ updates the page. No need to clone anymore!

Follow these steps:

- Open the local page you want to merge into the HQ page
- 2. Go to the mergeinto field
- 3. Expand + Add Content
- 4. Select Add existing content
- 5. Locate the HQ page you want to merge your local page into and select it





Merging Pages 2/2

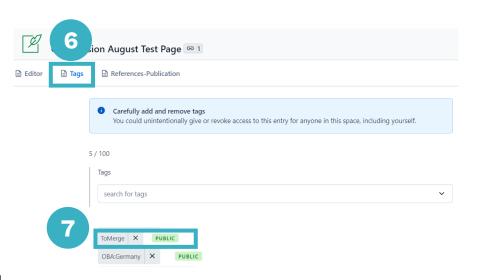

Continue with these steps:

- 6. Go to Tags
- 7. Add the **ToMerge** tag

After the merge takes place on the designated day, local page goes to draft mode and the **ToMerge** tag will be replaced by new tag **mergedPage**



Archiving Merged Pages

To archive the merged page, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to **Tags**
- 2. Remove local OBA tag(s)
- 3. Add the **Archived-Slugs** tag
- 4. Go to **slug** field and write ,archived' in the Master Content as well as the local slug fields
- 5. Go to the **General** tab
- 6. Select your locale
- 7. Finally**, Archive** the page
