# Programme of Works

## March Review

#### 1 Mercer Walk

During March, the final delivery of the brewery equipment took place, allowing the Braukon install team to open up works on all fronts. The result of this has allowed the brewery pipe install to reach level 2 where it too is now at final stages. As seen in the images, the centrepiece brewery tanks have been delivered and positioned, an exciting step in the programme as the project moves closer to a fully functioning brewery. Last month, the newsletter detailed the advancing first fix drylining, this has since been completed, and second fix on level 1 is in the latter stages. M&E saw positive progress last month and has continued to do so throughout March with first fix now complete to level 1 and levels 2 and 3 both over halfway done. The new steel staircase has been installed and screeded ready for first fix M&E and floor finishes following shortly after.

#### 28 - 32 Shelton Street

Shelton Street has seen all concrete works now completed, making way for screeding works to take place to the respective slabs, that is now at 70% completion. Steady progress to Drylining has been seen on levels 1, 2 & 5, coinciding with the completion of fire protection to steels across the building. Down in the basement, M&E has progressed with the install of the main water tank and associated pumps. S1 stairs have also arrived and install is underway with S2 stairs to follow in the month of May.

## 5 Langley Street

Langley Street is an area where works have really ramped up in the reporting period, with labourer levels up on all the core trades currently completing the fit out works. A challenging design has been overcome with the completion of the fire treatment works made to the soffits, this has enabled M&E to start in March and is now at 50% completed for first fix. Screeding works are also fully completed. Focus has also been partly shifted to the ground level of Langley, seeing the alteration and addition of structural steels to the main entrance, in preparation for the statement black brick which will be fitted later in the programme. Alongside this is the Passenger Lift and stairs fabrication, both important elements to this area of the project.

## 15 Neal Street

Upon completion of M&E in Neal Street, the focus shifts to Curtain Walling. This is now in the manufacture stage, looking towards an install date of late April.



## Old Brewer's Yard and the Tap Room Bar

Exploratory and breaking out works have allowed the canopy design to reach a new stage, with steels set to be installed in the Tap Room Mezzanine area in the near future. The Yard still also provides essential storage on site for subcontractors.

# Planned Activities for April 2025

#### 1 Mercer Walk

- Electrical install to Brewery equipment to commence
- M&E first fix to complete on ground floor
- 2<sup>nd</sup> fix drylining to commence on ground floor
- 2<sup>nd</sup> fix drylining to complete on level 1
- M&E 2<sup>nd</sup> fix to commence on level 1
- M&E first fix to complete on level 2
- Drylining 2<sup>nd</sup> fix to commence on level 2
- Brewery install to complete on level 2
- Roofing works to commence

#### 28-32 Shelton Street

- Floor preparation to complete throughout
- M&E first fix to commence on the upper levels
- Stair install to commence
- Drylining 1st fix complete on 1, 2 and 5

#### 15 Neal Street

- Movement of hoarding further on to Neal street to allow curtain wall install
- Curtain wall install to commence late April

## 5 Langley Street

- M and E first fix to complete
- 2<sup>nd</sup> fix drylining to begin
- Brickwork to commence at main entrance
