WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the Conservative Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The fund aims to provide moderate protection for your investment, while also providing a modest level of return over the medium term. Invests in mainly income assets with a small amount in growth assets.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

Risk indicator for the Conservative Fund¹:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

WHAT FEES ARE INVESTORS CHARGED?

Investors in the Conservative Fund are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2019 these were:

EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Katie had \$10,000 in the fund at 31 July 2018 and did not make any further contributions. At 30 June 2019, Katie received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$489 (that is 4.89% of her initial \$10,000). Katie did not pay other charges. This gives Katie a total return after tax of \$489 for the period.

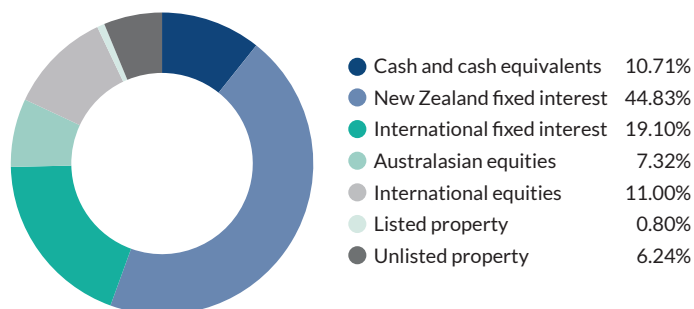

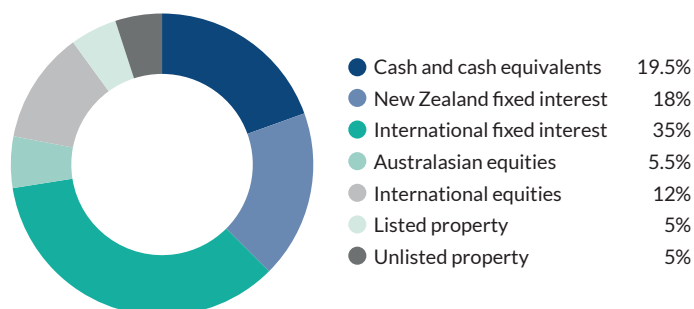
Actual investment mix

NOTES

- ³ The Conservative Fund was introduced on 31 July 2018. The annual fund charges have been estimated by annualising the eight months fees and expenses to 31 March 2019 and using the 30 June 2019 net asset value for the fund.
