Online training and resources target:

- For school or program leader: developing and implementing a comprehensive child protection strategy based on best practices
- For all staff: recognizing, responding to, and reporting child abuse and neglect
- For all staff: recognizing and reporting staff misconduct
- For those teaching lessons: teaching student lessons effectively

Adult caregiver materials target:

- Child sexual abuse awareness
- Talking to children about personal safety
- Responding appropriately to disclosure of child sexual abuse

Safe and supportive environment strategies for all staff target:

- Fostering positive relationships with students
- Creating safety and support for students experiencing maltreatment or difficulties

Student lessons and reinforcement activities target:

- Identifying common safety rules
- Recognizing, reporting, and refusing unsafe situations and touches and sexually abusive touch

- Increased implementation by school or program leader of a comprehensive child protection strategy
- Increased motivation and preparedness of staff to recognize, respond to, and report child abuse and neglect
- Increased awareness of caregivers of child sexual abuse and offender patterns
- Increased motivation and preparedness of caregivers to talk to children about personal safety
- Increased preparedness of caregivers to respond in a supportive way to disclosure
- Increased fidelity of implementation of student lessons
- Increased student knowledge of personal safety rules
- Increased student ability to recognize, report, and refuse unsafe and sexually abusive situations and touches

- Reduced incidence of unsafe and abusive touch at school
- Increased reporting by staff of child abuse and neglect
- Increased number of caregivers talking to children about personal safety
- Increased disclosure by students of unsafe and sexually abusive situations and touches
