





PROTECTION UNIT **Keeping Kids Safe from Abuse**

Early Learning - Providing extensive online training, age-appropriate lessons, and family education materials, the Second Step Child Protection Unit addresses all aspects of school-based child protection so educators, families, and children have the tools they need to recognize and effectively respond to abuse.

Staff Training

Take an integrated approach to child safety by providing training for every staff member and all other adults in your building.

Module 1 Helps administrators create or revise their child protection strategy, then create customized policies and procedures to help reduce risk of staff misconduct.

Module 2 Teaches staff to recognize indicators of abuse and neglect through realistic scenarios, respond supportively to children who experience abuse, and report abuse.

Module 3 Instructs teachers and counselors about how to teach the lessons, engage families, and overcome discomfort in talking to students about touching safety.

Each module takes 45-90 minutes.

The research-based Second Step Bullying Prevention Unit gives educators and school staff the training and tools they need to effectively address school bullying while teaching students to recognize, report, and refuse bullying themselves.




