Thomas Brown (1733-1820) of Charlton, Saratoga County, New York served on active duty in the American Revolutionary War from July through October, 1777. He was commissioned as a 1st lieutenant in the New York Militia, 12th Regiment from the Half-Moon and Ballston Districts October 20, 1775, and promoted to Captain, June 22, 1778, serving under Colonels Van Schoonhoven, John Knickerbocker and Peter Yates in the Albany County Militia. The 12th Regiment of Albany County, New York Militia was called to active duty in July 1777 at Half Moon, New York to reinforce General Horatio Gate's Continental Army during the Saratoga Campaign. The 12th Regiment served under Brigadier General Abraham Ten Broeck's Brigade in the Battles of Freeman's Farm on September 19th and at Bemis Heights in General Gates "Left Wing" of the battle on October 7, 1777. With the defeat of General John Burgoyne's British Army on October 17, 1777, the regiment "stood down." These two battles of Saratoga are generally acknowledged to be the turning point of the Revolution encouraging the French to support the
