TOP TIPS FOR EV CHARGING ETIQUETTE

- Plan ahead – allow extra time for charging.
- Only use an EV charging bay if you are charging your vehicle.
- Don't hog the EV bay – aim to move your vehicle as soon as you have sufficient charge or it has reached 80%.
- Charge at the correct speed for your vehicle – only use the rapid charger if your model is suitable.
- Communicate with fellow EV drivers - If someone is waiting, let them know how long you think you'll be.

1 WINCHESTER

Shell Recharge, Barfield Close, SO23 9SQ. After charging, head to St. Catherine's Park & Ride and follow signs to St. Catherine's Hill for the start of the walk.

2 QUEEN ELIZABETH COUNTRY PARK (QEC)

Shell Recharge, South Downs Way, PO8 0QE. Discover QEC and follow the signs there to Butser Hill, the highest point on the South Downs Way.
