For our products we have a very high standard of quality. We constantly check them for compliance with European and national regulations and directives and international standards. Here are the key points and most important laws, guidelines and regulations:

- → Our toys are subject to the European Toys Directive 2009/48/EC.
- ➡ Because many of our products are intended for private use, they are subject to the requirements of the EU General Product Safety Directive 2001/95/EC (amended by Regulation No. 596/2009/EC).
- → For our electronic products, the following guidelines must be adhered to:
 - Low Voltage Directive 2014/35/EU
 - o ROHS 2011/65/EC
 - o EMV Directive 2014/30/EU
 - RED Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU
- → Our products must comply with REACH Regulation 1907/2006.
- → Our products, materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, must comply with LFBG Regulation 1935/2004/EC.
- → For packaging, the **Packaging Act (VerpackG)** must be complied with since 01.01.2019.

Additional guidelines, regulations and standards may apply to special products, which must then also be complied with and implemented. This applies e.g. for personal protective equipment, cosmetics or medical devices.

Further requirements are communicated to suppliers by our quality assurance to the HABA FAMILYGROUP of companies.
