Aspiring woodworkers can concentrate entirely on their training. During the first year, basic technical training takes place in the company training





workshop. This lays the foundation for successful vocational training. The apprentices learn about wood as a material from the ground up so that they can later work independently using state-of-the-art technology. Over the course of their apprenticeship, the young junior employees are introduced to a wide range of production areas at the Bad Rodach site. They support the production of toys, furniture, and solid wood items and can thus explore their potential future field of application.

Laura Holecek had the best marks in Bavaria in her final exam as a marketing communications administrator.
