NR2F1 Research Strategy meeting - October 7, Denver, Colorado





What a weekend! After our Strategic Planning weekend with the board in Atlanta at the start of the year, we were excited to bring together our board and Scientific Advisors to build out our Research Roadmap.

On October 7 we all came together at the University of Denver. We had Dr Schaaf (the 'S' in BB**S**OAS!), Dr. Henning Fröhlich and Johann Maaß, medical student, all from the University of Heidelberg. Dr. Michele Studer from the University of Nice, France, Dr. Veeral Shah, neuro-ophthamologist from Cincinnati Childrens Hospital and Dr. Anna Pfalzer from COMBINEDBrain.

The day began by hosting local BBSOAS families for 'breakfast with the scientists', a powerful reminder of why we were all there. The <u>agenda</u> was then full to bursting! The purpose of the meeting was to develop a research strategy and build a roadmap for moving forward. This is the first <u>strategic research meeting</u> that the foundation has had that joined all NR2F1 / BBSOAS researchers together in one room to collaborate and brainstorm a research roadmap.

What do we need the money for? We've come up with a 3 year Research Roadmap and a list of initiatives we would like to initiate - which ofcourse comes along with a hefty price tag. - 1. Fund 3 Post Doctoral researchers for 3 years to work alongside our lead scientists to exclusively research NR2F1 and BBSOAS (will require year 2 and 3 fundraising in addition)
- 2. Create a NR2F1 New Investigator grant to attract junior researchers to research the NR2F1 gene
- 3. Develop a new mouse model
- Biomarkers host a biorepository collection at our 2024
 Family Conference and develop a BBSOAS biomarker

All year we have partnered with COMBINEDBrain to collect BBSOAS bio samples (e.g. blood and urine), to be used by researchers in future projects.
