Providing Support Through Monumental Change

A CONVERSATION WITH DR. KENNETH ROTH, PRESIDENT, AND PAUL DURR, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Durr: I'm pleased to announce that once again despite the on-going challenges we faced in the second year of the global pandemic, the medical group performed well financially in 2021. However, as we move forward almost two full years into the crisis, I think it's clear that some things will likely never go back to the way they were before COVID-19. The world changed and continues to change as people pause to reevaluate their lives and their priorities.

Roth: Yes Paul, and as people's priorities shifted, many people have chosen to leave the medical field and try new career paths. With many people deciding not to return to work, jobs are plentiful and demand for workers is high, which may also be prompting people to pursue other opportunities. Many of our practices are struggling with staff turnover or staff shortages as a result, putting additional stress on our physicians.

Durr: I'm hearing stories about staffing issues, as are the various teams that interact with and support our practices. Fortunately, we have a resource to assist practices that are struggling with staffing challenges and other aspects of running a practice through SmartCareMD Practice Management. SmartCareMD is now a wholly owned subsidiary of SCMG. The skilled and experienced team is available to assist practices that are struggling.

Roth: I'm glad you mentioned SmartCareMD. I've talked with numerous fellow physicians who have recently reached out for assistance from the SmartCareMD team. And for any primary care physicians who want to give up managing their own business, but who still want to practice medicine, SharpCare Medical Group offers an employment model that may be a viable option.

Durr: Those are two great examples of how SCMG goes above and beyond most Independent Practice Associations (IPAs). I'm proud of how SCMG continues to evolve in order to meet the changing needs of our physicians and remain a relevant player in the San Diego health care market.

Roth: I agree Paul. It's important that SCMG continues to find new ways to support private practice and at the same time, remain profitable. Many of our practices rely on the financial support they receive from SCMG to keep their practices afloat. I'm especially proud of how much money we paid out to our practices this year to help them weather COVID-19.

Durr: In 2021, we paid out \$3.6 million to the practices to make them whole related to COVID-19. Approximately \$2.0 million of that was what we call cost share, which are dollars

that are normally collected in office that were waived due to COVID-19. The other \$1.6 million were approved paid claims for COVID testing.

I am also pleased to report that in 2021, 157 SCMG physicians scored at or above the 90th percentile in Patient Experience, representing a 51% increase from 2020 and solidifying a strong positive trend in this important measure that demonstrates the excellent care our practices are delivering, and one of the key reasons we believe SCMG was able to grow our HMO membership by more than 12% over the previous fiscal year.

Roth: A truly outstanding accomplishment! In this highly competitive marketplace, the strong growth speaks volumes about the high quality, compassionate care our physicians deliver. I believe we were able to accomplish this feat largely because of how quickly our practices adopted to the virtual care environment that was necessary in order to keep seeing patients last year.

Durr: Yes Kenny. In 2021, SCMG physicians quickly embraced virtual visits, providing video and phone visits to roughly 208,000 SCMG patients, with an estimated reach to all patients of over 1 million visits. I'm moved by how positively physicians adapted by incorporating virtual care visits, along with the in-person care needed by some patients, to serve the community.

Roth: Other initiatives, like the addition of San Ysidro Health physicians to our network have no doubt also contributed to our growth, and hopefully will for years to come. I continue to be impressed with the creative leadership of the SCMG Executive team. At a time in history when many IPAs are disappearing, SCMG has managed to continue to attract new talent and grow profitability for the group. It is a true demonstration of why SCMG is one of the best IPAs in the country, and how we as independent practitioners continue to be **Better Together**.
