5. Co-Chair nominations due to vacancy

• Departure of Rob Setina has created an opening for a Co-Chair. The group is invited to nominate, a voting process will follow. (refer to <u>presentation deck</u> from meeting)

6. Regular Updates

- **a. GDSN statistics** Latest statistics showing 7.9% increase in product numbers globally on GDSN from Dec 2020. NPC is still 3rd largest data pool globally in healthcare. Link to where the detail is published is included in the presentation deck
- **b. NPC statistics** some increases in publishers since last update, new data recipient since previous (Uniting Care Health) and Certified Product Partners. Refer to presentation deck for details
- c. Data Quality Improvement progress –Platinum up to 64%, continued decreases to 'Red' at 17%. Top 5 errors largely consistent Missing Manufacturer name, UNSPSC code, manufacturer internal reference and Dimensional data being listed.
 - Questions from group:
 - **Discussion on data set review** Enquiry raised for the development of more tangible metric reporting for progress, including deliverables, timeframes, movements and where hold-ups are occurring.

ACTION: Creation of a dashboard visualisation of the project plan

- What are Certified Data pools within GDSN There are 40 datapools including the NPC that for part of the global network that is GDSN. Many operate commercially across multiple markets, NPC focusses on Australia and N7.
- How does this differ from a Certified Product Partner A CPP is a solution provider who has been certified as enable to manage the data processes related to loading data into the NPC and maintaining it using the standard choreography, messages and data structures.
- What is the distinction between the Data Quality Levels (Platinum down to Red) Each level has a specific definition with regard to the level of tolerance regarding errors with Platinum being 100% free of errors. The errors themselves relate to the machine validations that are run over the data contained in a suppliers catalogue.
- Size of the NPC Datapool compared to others how is it the 3rd largest. Contributing factors to achieving status of 3rd largest data pool in healthcare is because we started adoption ahead of some of many other countries. The two larger data pools are based in the US and Europe.
- **d. AMT CTPP/GTIN project update** Increase of 25% since Jan 2021. Seeking to accelerate the progress, a further outreach will be coordinated for suppliers of products deemed AMT-CTPP applicable.
 - 4,895 NPC records have a valid AMT-CTPP code
 - 30 NPC records contain a deprecated code (replacement available)
 - 96 NPC records contain an invalid AMT-CTPP code
 - 4,647 NPC records have been identified as probable AMT-CTPP applicable records (not populated)
 - Currently all deprecated AMT-CTPP codes are communicated to GS1 and are actioned as part of the data quality insights reporting.

• Discussion on AMT-CTPP

Australian Medicines Terminology / Container Trade Product Pack attributes are supported within the NPC data set. AMT-CTPP data is used in electronic health records and clinical systems to generically identify clinical concepts of medicines. The linkage between AMT for clinical concept and GTIN for physical product is critical. Many health organisations view AMT CTPP/GTIN data linkage as one of the most important data elements to support medication management and safety.

ACTION: Development of Communication/demonstration of the usage to help ensure understanding of importance, versus only technical creation of the code



e. Recipient Program Updates

1. Sigma (update sent ahead of meeting)

NPC remains a focus for all Sigma suppliers moving forward. Request raised for improved way to manage active ingredients and inclusion of PBS codes in Data Quality.

2. ACT Health - Ryan Mavin / Ian Bull

A project underway to improve their supply chain solution which will be a catalyst to driving consumption and value of NPC data via synchronisation. Also, implementation of Epic EMR and usage of AMT-CTPP linkage in NPC to assist with medicines discharge and admission scenarios.

Currently looking into use of integrated data from NPC for Merlin (dispensing system) and also use of NPC data in theatre systems (DHR program).

7. General Discussion

NPC user surveys

- NPC user feedback was collected confidentially and summarised for the group
- Key recurring themes discussed were user awareness of how NPC works, ongoing manual workarounds, recipient data usage/feedback not visible to suppliers, data quality concerns which will be delved into.

Discussion:

Value proposition sizing has been completed over many years but remains not well understood. A better understanding requires whole of industry approach, what is needed to clarify the value proposition and refine the process?

Potential of workshops to help tease out the challenges (supported by Elizabeth Donohoo and Kamlesh Lal)

Greater visibility of recipient data usage (including hierarchy) and understanding of the reasons for non-use are needed.

HealthShare Vic confirming use of NPC data in the contracts process and the downstream availability of contracted and non-contracted items at Health Services level via their catalogue systems – but this is possibly not visible. Supplier score and dashboard reporting to support data synch.

ACTION: Workshop discussions in separate groups – Recipient and Supplier to help review challenges further

ACTION: Addition of greater details related to where the data is used beyond the central recipient (ie: data published to Healthshare Victoria is accessible to all health services across Victoria)

Improvements in Process

Visibility of Recipient Requirements on GS1 website to provide a better linkage to
information such as statements, contacts and current activities. Working with recipients
to enrich this information – suggestion to provide more information on the breadth of
reach from those recipients.

ACTION: All Recipients to provide details for inclusion on the new page to ensure visibility of their requirements

ACTION: Addition of greater details related to where the data is used beyond the central recipient (ie: data published to Healthshare Victoria is accessible to all health services across Victoria)

 Improved access to Healthcare information on GS1 website, NPC specific information, user tools and guides for trans-Tasman users - all in easier to access locations on GS1 website.

ACTION: Advisory Group members invited to continue to provide feedback on areas of improvement



Dataset Review

- Implementation time frames changes to Target Data Set to be finalised later in June, with some additional attributes to be deployed in August. (refer 6c for agreed action to provide greater visibility of dates/status)
- Primary changes to dataset:
 - Replacing generic 'AU Healthcare Industry' and 'Pharmacy Wholesale (Aust)'
 with product focussed datasets for 'Medical Devices' and 'Pharmaceutical'.
 - Update of requirement flags and status keys to remove ambiguity around required attributes.
 - Replace alphabetical listing of attributes to logical groupings.
- Specific Attribute changes:
 - Warranty Attributes Medical Devices
 - Warranty Description
 - Warranty Duration + UOM
 - Warranty Effective Date Type
 - Allergen Information Pharmaceutical Medicines
 - o Allergen Type Code
 - Level of Containment
 - Material Medical Devices
 - o Material Statement Description
 - ${\scriptstyle \circ \; material Code, \; material Content, \; material Percentage, \; material Treatment}$
 - Product Sponsor Medical Devices & Pharmaceutical

Planning to implement project in Q4 2021. Expect that this change will have a significant positive impact for the community for data quality.

- Locatenet (sister platform to NPC developed within NeHTA Supply Chain program) will be migrated to the new and improved National Location Registry platform later in the year. This new platform is the result of collaboration with the Department of Infrastructure and will deliver improvements to UI as well as additional data attributes designed to assist in freight management processes and visibility.
