Appendix A: SFTP Process

Username & Password	Username and password will be sent to the nominated contact on this order form
Directory Structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inbox (customers collect files here) Outbox (customer send files from here)
Upload Process	i. Logon to InTouch (gateway.leadtec.com.au) using Username & Password ii. Change directory to Outbox (cd Outbox) iii. Upload the file (put xxx) the file name is not used
Download Process	i. Logon to InTouch (gateway.leadtec.com.au) using Username & Password ii. Change directory to Inbox (cd Inbox) iii. Download files (mget *) iv. Once the files are downloaded, delete the files (DEL *)
Additional Comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Files can only be deleted if they have been downloaded in the same session from which the delete command is run Once a file is downloaded it will appear to have been deleted. However if a delete command is not run within the same session, the file will be marked as unread and made available again in approximately 30 minutes The delete command will only delete files that have been successfully downloaded
