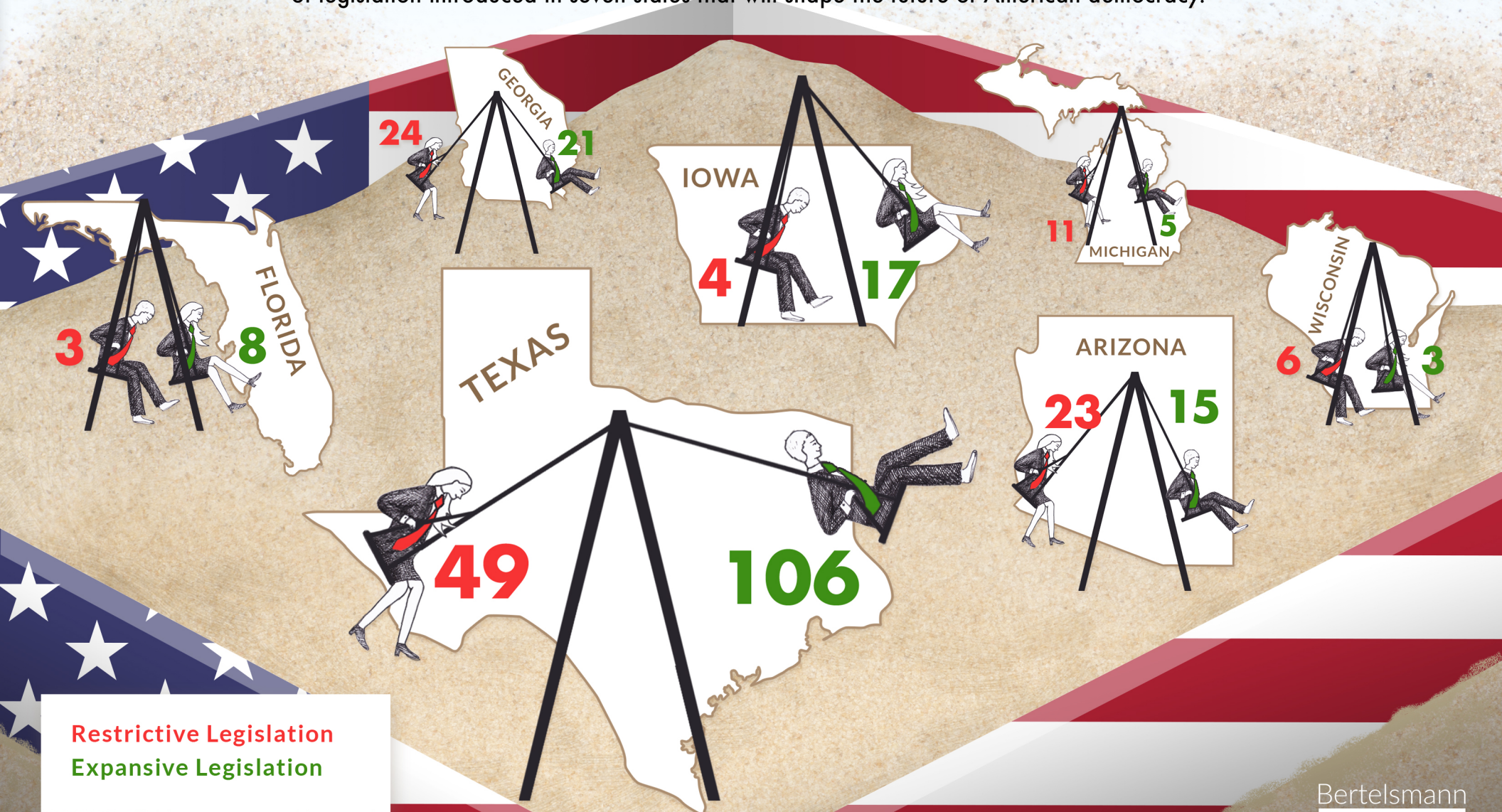


AMERICAN DEMOCRACY ON UNSTABLE GROUND
