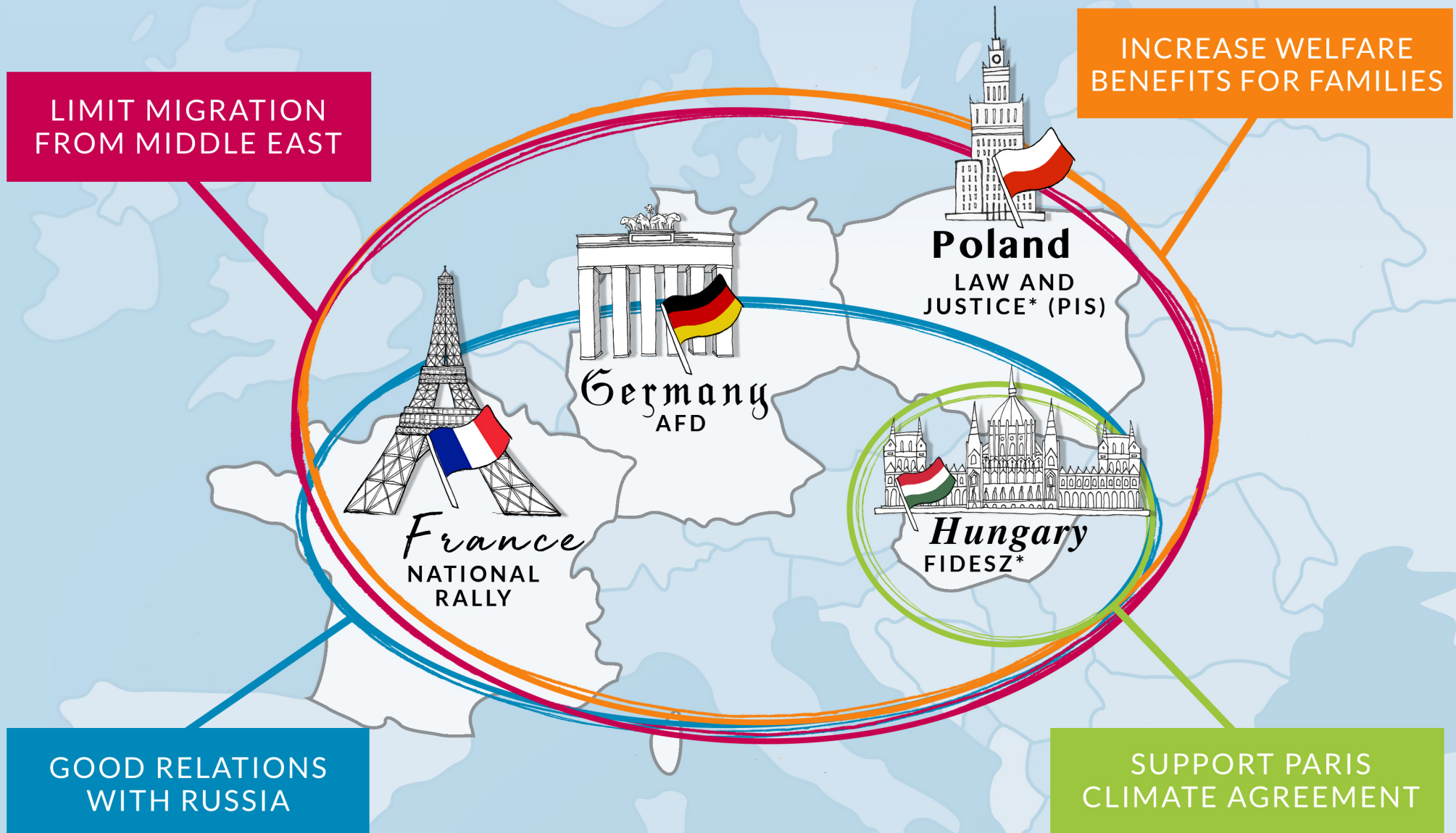


WHAT DO EUROPE'S RIGHT-WING PARTIES WANT?



GOOD RELATIONS WITH RUSSIA

Poland's PiS has taken a much more cautious approach to Moscow. Many party members blame Russia for the 2010 plane crash that killed President Lech Kaczyński, the twin brother of PiS leader Jaroslaw Kaczyński.

INCREASE WELFARE BENEFITS FOR FAMILIES

In recent years, some right-wing parties have taken on traditionally left-wing attitudes toward social welfare. PiS's popular 500 Plus program provides a sizable stipend to families with two children or more.

LIMIT MIGRATION FROM MIDDLE EAST

Across the board, all the parties advocate strongly for limiting immigration – especially from the Middle East and North Africa.

SUPPORT PARIS CLIMATE AGREEMENT

Hungary's Viktor Orban (Fidesz) supports the Paris agreement and has publicly argued that more should be done to combat climate change. However, the party has not taken much action to follow through.
