## What you need to do each season



Things to do in your home to keep it running smoothly all year round.

<ul> <li>Make sure your <u>smoke alarms</u> and <u>carbon monoxide detectors</u> are working</li> <li>Check your boiler pressure</li> <li>Prune/sweep the garden as you go</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Make sure your appliances are clean and working well</li> <li>Keep on top of any damp/moisture</li> <li>Deep cleaning</li> </ul>
Clean your fascias and gutters Get your roof checked Spruce up the garden Repaint/repair your fences Spring cleaning – carpet cleaning, wash pillows/duvets, defrost your freezer, clean the fridge/freezer, empty and clean cupboards Fix any plumbing issues whilst the heating is off/low Jet wash patios and furniture ready for the summer Check air conditioning – replace filters or service if it's been longer than a year	Clean your windows and doors Repaint the external walls and gates Repaint indoor walls Thoroughly clear loft/basement Repointing of brickwork if needed Prune any large trees or shrubs to reduce water consumption Get your boiler serviced ready for the autumn/winter Pump septic tank
Get your chimney swept  Check any flat roofs for damage or sitting water  Bleed your radiators ready for the winter  Clean and store any garden furniture  Clean gutters and drainage holes from any dropped leaves, and make sure all pipes are secure too  Insulate any external pipes or taps to prevent them from freezing	Check your fences and any trees to make sure they're sturdy – remove any branches you think may fall  Keep an eye on your roof to make sure no tiles have slipped  Prevent damp by opening windows, using dehumidifiers and running central heating  Clear any snow from paths  Seal any gaps if draughts are coming in  Keep your gutters and drains clear from debris
