STATEMENT TSCA, SECTION 6(H)

FRABA produces electronic and electrical equipment (EEE) for use in industrial environments. FRABA supports

EPA's goals, particularly the goal of improving the health and safety of citizens and promoting environmental pro-

tection.

On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published final rules under the Toxic Sub-

stances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) to restrict the importation and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative, and

toxic (PBT) chemicals. None of the five listed chemicals will be intentionally added by FRABA at the manufacturing

of products neither inside nor outside our US manufacturing sites. Three of the chemicals, 2,4,6 TTBP, HCBD and $\frac{1}{2}$

PCTP might be used as intermediates for the manufacturing of electronic components but are not expected to be

in electronic components. EEE containing DecaBDE are forbidden to be put onto the EU market by the RoHS

directive.

All FRABA products are conform to the RoHS directive and consequently free of DecaBDE. Therefore, FRABA can

state to the best of its knowledge that none of the five chemicals banned by EPA per TSCA are present in FRABA

products.
