
Reykjavik Excursions offer a wide selection of guided Golden Circle tours for those who want to see the best of Iceland.



Northern Lights Tours




The northern lights are caused by the interaction of particles from the sun with the upper atmosphere near the North Pole. That creates this wonderful light effect, known as the aurora borealis (northern lights). The northern lights are a spectacular natural phenomenon, often seen dancing around in fantastic colours across the Icelandic Arctic sky.

Following the cave adventure, we relax at the geothermal pool at Húsafell before returning back to Reykjavik.
