


Þórsmörk Adventure

Þórsmörk is one of Iceland's most beautiful spots; green-sloped, covered in low willow, birch and heather woodland and wildflowers, with icy peaks rising above - a "must see" during your stay in Iceland.

Þórsmörk (Thor's Wood) was created by glacial streams running off from underneath the icecaps of Eyjafjallajökull and Mýrdalsjökull and it is a favorite among hikers as it is the base for many interesting hiking trails.

A magnet for everyone from hard-core hikers to energetic nature lovers.

Things to do

The summit of Valahnúkur (458m) has a view disc on top that identifies all the surrounding mountains, valleys and glaciers within the far-ranging vista.

The area is the perfect base for all sorts of hikes, both short and long, suitable for just about anyone.

P Both the Laugavegur and Fimmvörðuháls trails run through the area, which are among Iceland's most popular hiking trails.



HIKING FIMMVÖRÐUHÁLS

IOYO 11-11a

This trail is one of the most popular hiking trails in Iceland and is a favourite among the locals. Reykjavík – Landmannalaugar The hike usually starts in Landmannalaugar and from there it is a 3-4 days hike to Þórsmörk

This trail is extremely popular and it takes you through a pass between the glaciers Eyjafjallajökull and Mýrdalsjökull and takes about 8-10 hours to complete, depending on the hiker's pace. Travellers can even do the hike in 2 days, spending a night in the hut in Fimmvörðuháls en route.

HIKING LAUGAVEGUR & FIMMVÖRÐUHÁLS

By taking Laugavegur and Fimmvörðuháls trails in a combo you will get the best out of both.

The Hiking Pass is valid for 2 of the 3 the following routes when travelling to and from the trail.

10Y0 9-9a

Reykjavík - Þórsmörk / Þórsmörk - Reykjavík (route operated 1 June - 20 September)

Landmannalaugar - Reykjavík (route operated 14 June – 15 September)

IOYO 21-21a

Reykjavík - Skógar / Skógar – Reykjavík (route operated 1 July - 31 August)











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
