Þórsmörk Adventure

Þórsmörk is one of Iceland's most beautiful spots; green-sloped, covered in low willow, birch and heather woodland and wildflowers, with icy peaks rising above - a "must see" during your stay in Iceland.

Þórsmörk (Thor's Wood) was created by glacial streams running off from underneath the icecaps of Eyjafjallajökull and Mýrdalsjökull and it is a favorite among hikers as it is the base for many interesting hiking trails.

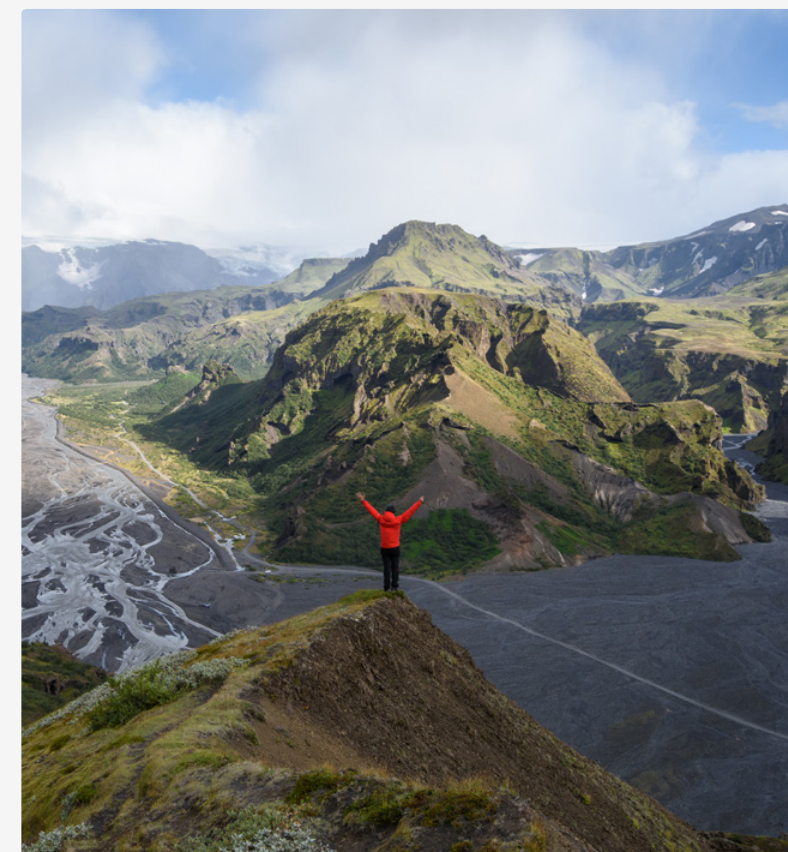
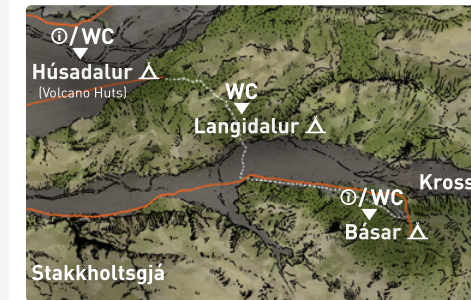
A magnet for everyone from hard-core hikers to energetic nature lovers.

Things to do

☞ The summit of Valahnúkur (458m) has a view disc on top that identifies all the surrounding mountains, valleys and glaciers within the far-ranging vista.

☞ The area is the perfect base for all sorts of hikes, both short and long, suitable for just about anyone.

☞ Both the Laugavegur and Fimmvörðuháls trails run through the area, which are among Iceland's most popular hiking trails.

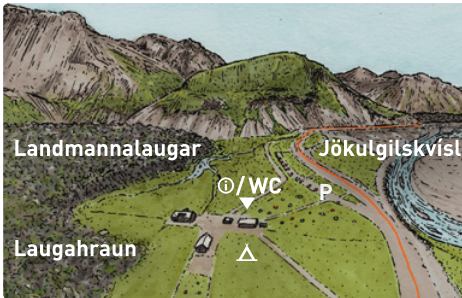

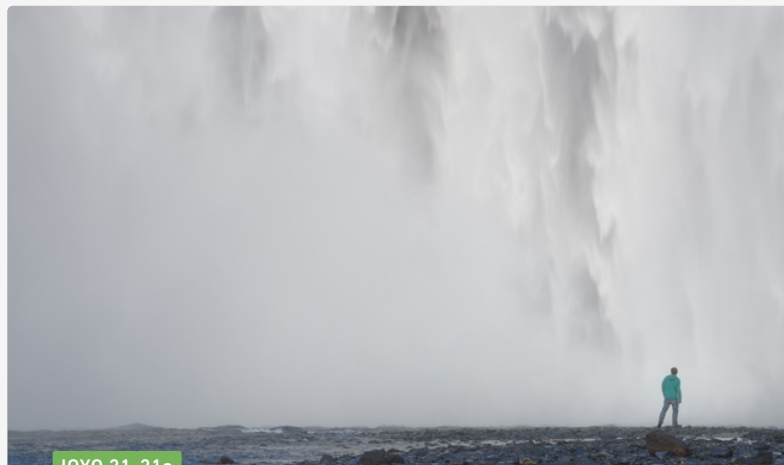

Skógar Adventure

The route takes you through the Southern Icelandic countryside with green fields, farms, smaller villages and waterfalls until you reach the tiny settlement at Skógar. Above the village are the white heights of Eyjafjallajökull glacier and its precipitous green foothills.

At Skógar you can walk to the picturesque 62m high Skógafoss waterfall and you might even be tempted to take the steps all the way up to the top and enjoy the scenery.

Visit the South and enjoy the sights.

Things to do

👉 Visit the wonderful Skógar folk museum which covers all aspects of Icelandic life.

👉 The very popular Fimmvörðuháls hiking trail to Þórsmörk nature reserve begins or ends in Skógar. This broad pass between Eyjafjallajökull and Mýralsjökull makes a great one day hike from Skógar.

Hiking Pass

The Iceland On Your Own Hiking Pass is the ideal way to experience two of Iceland's most popular hiking routes on your own. You simply purchase the pass and with it you get a bus transfer from Reykjavík to the base of the hike and back again to Reykjavík from the hike's end point when you are done.

Hiking Options:

HIKING LAUGAVEGUR

This trail is one of the most popular hiking trails in Iceland and is a favourite among the locals. The hike usually starts in Landmannalaugar and from there it is a 3-4 days hike to Þórsmörk nature reserve.

HIKING FIMMVÖRÐUHÁLS

This trail is extremely popular and it takes you through a pass between the glaciers Eyjafjallajökull and Mýrdalsjökull and takes about 8-10 hours to complete, depending on the hiker's pace. Travellers can even do the hike in 2 days, spending a night in the hut in Fimmvörðuháls en route.

HIKING LAUGAVEGUR & FIMMVÖRÐUHÁLS

By taking Laugavegur and Fimmvörðuháls trails in a combo you will get the best out of both.
