

Policy Statement

MAN Enterprise group is committed to protecting its information assets against all possible threats, whether internal or external, deliberate or accidental, to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of information. To support this commitment, MAN Enterprise group has established an Information Security Management System (ISMS) that provides a structured framework for identifying, assessing, and managing information security risks, setting measurable objectives, and implementing appropriate controls. This policy applies to all employees, contractors, vendors, and third parties with access to MAN Enterprise group information or systems.

Top Management is responsible for the overall effectiveness of the ISMS and for ensuring that adequate resources, direction, and support are provided. Clearly defined roles and responsibilities related to information security are established, documented, and communicated across the organization. All personnel are required to comply with this policy and its associated information security procedures and are expected to protect company assets as part of their daily responsibilities.

MAN Enterprise group is committed to complying with all applicable legal, statutory, regulatory, and contractual requirements related to information security. This includes adherence to relevant national and international standards, client requirements, and industry's best practices.

MAN Enterprise group is dedicated to the continual improvement of its ISMS to ensure it remains effective and responsive to evolving business needs, technological advancements, and emerging security threats.

Compliance with this policy is mandatory. Violations may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment or contract, as well as legal action where applicable.

This policy shall be reviewed at least annually, or upon significant changes to the organization, to ensure its ongoing suitability, adequacy, and effectiveness.
