The BeyondTrust Privileged Remote Access Web Console is a web application that allows the user to view and control a remote device.

No significant UI changes have been made since the last report.

Evaluation Methods Used

Assistive technology products used as part of testing included Freedom Scientific JAWS 2025, NVDA 2024.3, Freedom Scientific ZoomText 2025, Microsoft Windows accessibility features, and keyboard-only control. Testing was performed with this assistive technology on Chrome and Firefox on Windows 11.
