

Activity 1



Activity 2

Activity 3

It's now time to plan your story. Interesting stories include an unexpected event, a crisis or a problem in the middle of the story, that needs to be sorted out by the end. Your story plan includes some ideas of problems that could happen in your story. You can choose your own if you have an idea.

Opening – how will your story start? You can include details on your main character and setting in the opening.	 Problem – what unexpected event or problem will happen in the middle of your story? Someone or something could get lost. Something important could get stolen. A special machine could break down.
Resolution – how will your character sort the problem out?	Ending – how will your story end?

Your final task is to write a short story about an unexpected event that happens in the strange world your monster lives in. Use the story plan and words and phrases you have written about your main character and setting to help you.
