Essential & Functional Cookies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Essential Cookies are also sometimes called “strictly necessary” they are automatically dropped onto your computer, tablet or mobile when you access our websites as they are essential for our website to function correctly. Functional cookies allow us to remember any preferences you’ve made and we use them to improve your online experience. These cookies are anonymous and don’t track browsing activity across other websites.
Personalisation & Re-targeting cookies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Personalisation cookies help us to tailor our website based on your interests. They tell us how you’re using the site, so we can show you products and offers that might be of interest to you. Targeted cookies are used by advertisers on our website. They track your browser when you visit different websites to understand what you're interested in and use this information to display more relevant adverts to you on other websites.
Analytical & Tracking Cookies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Analytical & Tracking cookies are used to track visitors on the website. How you browse, how long are you staying on the site, what you are looking at and when you have made a purchase. They are essential in measuring customer experience, the performance of a website, and to optimise it.

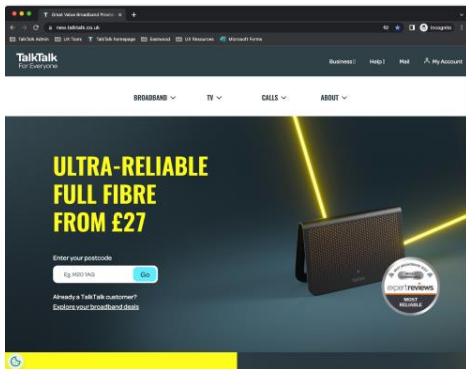

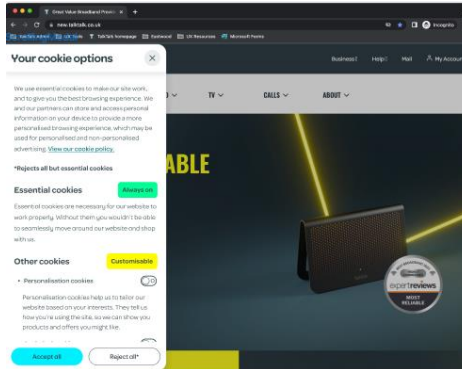
How to manage your cookies
