Pharma reputation is up, but will it last?

Pharma, BioTech, & Life Sciences have delivered against the increased global attention, increasing their reputation score **3.0** points to **72.8**.

But sentiment is different stateside

Global Pharma reputation is up, but the US remains cautiously optimistic — even into 2021, with a more subtle reputation increase.

Individual reputation is up, but Johnson is in for an interesting 2021

J&J saw a 2.8 point increase as their COVID vaccine was approved by the FDA and became available to the public.

And their individual Reputation Drivers saw increases, particularly their Citizenship rating — which monitors factors like "Positive influence on society" and "Supports good causes."

But in April 2021 (Q2), the CDC placed a pause on distribution of the vaccine pending an investigation. This could have a lasting effect on reputation.

RepTrak is continuing to collect data to continuously track effects on Pharma and J&J reputation.





These high scores are not a permanent stamp of approval, but a call to action to continuously meet this "halo glow" with actions and initiatives moving forward.
