WindO/I-NV4



Welcome to WindO/I-NV4!

Thank you for purchasing the "WindO/I-NV4".

The WindO/I-NV4 is software for the main unit (operator interface). WindO/I-NV4 can be used to create screens or program operations for the main unit. To set up main unit screens and operations, you must first create a project, then set up the devices and working environment. Next, place the parts like switches and displays on the screen to prepare for the operations. Finally, download the created project to the main unit to construct the operating environment.

Highlights of WindO/I-NV4 are as follows.

Easy-to-use workspace

The project's structure is clear at a first glance. Switching to editing could be done in a oneclick manner. The WindO/I-NV4 provides you with an efficient working environment and a high degree of freedom for creating screens.

Managing text data collectively with the text manager function

You can collectively manage the text used in the switch and lamp names and the alarm function. Text settings (font, text, text color, size, etc.) can be exported to a CSV format file, and by importing the file after editing with general-purpose software such as Excel. This management functionality helps the user to achieve efficient editing of the project.

Easy setup of parts' trigger conditions

The trigger conditions of switches and lamps, bit/word write, and goto screen commands can be set easily in the properties of each part. The status (OFF – ON - OFF) of the lamp can be set with ease as well.

Reuse of data

Screen data and scripts from different projects can be reused, making effective use of software assets. Image data in BMP, JPG, WMF, and ICO file formats are also reusable.

Tag Editor's Cross Reference function provides ease of access to the used device

The Tag Editor, which is the same GUI as WindO/I-NV3 and WindLDR, can be shared and used, making it easy to check the device addresses used in the project and replace the device addresses.

Notes - WindO/I-NV4

There are the following notes for using WindO/I-NV4. Thank you for your understanding.

Text and Fonts

- 1) For character input such as a "Registration Text" or a "Message Display", which has character restrictions, a carriage return is equivalent to two characters.
- 2) The font, line, and resized image of the bitmap displayed on WindO/I-NV4 may appear differently on the main unit. So please check the appearance of the main unit.
- 3) If the DPI setting in Windows is greater than 100%, the dialog box may not be displayed properly. To display dialog properly, please set DPI setting to 100%.

Edit

- WindO/I-NV4 does not have a limitation for the number of editing windows which can be opened at the same time. The limitation depends on the RAM of the PC. If the editing window cannot be opened, then the warning message is displayed
- 2) If you want to input languages like Chinese or Korean on English OS, then please check the input procedure and notes on the manual and help.
- 3) Assume the "Fill" drawing is used in the NV Metafile and that NV Metafile is used in the image of the drawing or part object. If the user attempts to resize the placed object, then the "Fill" may leak over the designated area and may change the displayed image.
- 4) If "None", "Fore 100%", "Back 100%" or gradation pattern is not selected as Patterns in the property of the object, such as drawing and part, and "Place on the Top Layer" is ON, then the pattern is started from the left top side of the objects. If "Place on the Top Layer" is OFF, the pattern is started from the left top side of the screen.

Communication

- 1) The screen monitor may not update the value of the external device address set for write only. Please use Custom Monitor or Batch Monitor to monitor the device instead.
- 2) Do not write 16bit data or bit data to the 32bit device using the Emerson ROC Protocol driver.
- 3) Do not send more than one command at the same time if Ethernet is selected for the User Communication Interface.
- 4) The following points should be taken into consideration when "Automatically obtain the IP address" is selected.
 - It may take some time to obtain the IP address, and a communication error may occur. If a communication error occurs, then please download the project again.
 - Whenever downloading the project data, the MICTO/I obtain an IP address. Therefore an IP address may change.
 - While using the Monitor function, download the project after stopping the Monitor function.
- 5) When using the Modbus RTU Slave driver with the connection of 1:N, the Modbus RTU Master side must take into account the idle time* of 4.0 characters or more to the

transmission wait time. (FT2J/1J, HG2J/1J only)

(*Reference value: When Baud Rate is 9600bps, idle time is approximately 5.0 milliseconds)

6) For models where project data created with the new WindO/I-NV4 has been downloaded, it is not possible to upload the project data to a PC using an older version of WindO/I-NV4 (the upload may stop, or the project may not open and saved after the upload). Please use the same version of WindO/I-NV4 as the one used by the target model for uploading.

Touch Panel

When more than one spot is pressed at the same time, due to the detection characteristics of an analog-type touch panel, the center part of a pressed spot is registered and the operator interface assumes that only one spot is pressed. Thus, please avoid pressing multiple spots of the touch panel at the same time.

External Memory Device

If a FAT32 format USB memory is connected while running, the main unit scan time becomes temporarily longer by reading the information from the USB memory. (FT2J/1J, HG2J/1J only)

When the SNTP and Time Zone functions are enabled, the modified date may shift when writing folders and files to the external memory device. (FT2J/1J, HG2J/1J only)

Compatibility of WindO/I-NV2

The project file, which is created by WindO/I-NV2, can be opened by WindO/I-NV4. However, the project file should satisfy the following conditions.

- The project file is saved by WindO/I-NV2 Ver.4.80 or the newer version
- HG4G/3G(Multimedia), HG4G/3G, HG2G-5F, HG2G-S/2G-5S, or HG2G-S/2G-5S(Ethernet) are selected for the Product Series

If the following conditions are satisfied and drawing objects or part objects are overlapped on overlay screens, the display order of those objects may differ from that of WindO/I-NV2. To circumvent, enable the "Place on the Top Layer" check box in the property dialog box of those drawing objects or part objects.

- HG4G/3G(Multimedia), HG4G/3G, or HG2G-5F are selected as Product Series in the project
- An overlay screen is used

Compatibility of WindO/I-NV3

The project file, which is created by WindO/I-NV3, can be opened by WindO/I-NV4. However, the project file should satisfy the following conditions.

- The project file is saved by WindO/I-NV3 Ver.5.00 or the newer version

About WindO/I-NV4 version of HG3G-V8

Please use WindO/I-NV4 V2.0.1 or later version for HG3G-V8 shipped after May 2022.

When downloading a project using WindO/I-NV4 V2.0.0 or earlier, the following screen may appear during download.

<Runtime System Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- The following Communication Driver is supported.
 - Allen-Bradley Micro800 Controller Tags(Ethernet)
- The following improvements have been made to downloading a project file saved in an external memory.
 - ZNX project file or ZNV project file can be downloaded without clearing log data.
 - If the OS version included in the ZNX project file matches the OS version of FT2J/1J or HG2J/1J, the OS software download is skipped.
- In Global Script and Script Command, you can select "Write control devices and external device addresses only when value changes".
- Changes have been made to improve security when working with project data. (HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V models, HG4G/3G/2G-5F models, HG2G-5T models, HG1G/1P models)
- > Shorten the time to display parts that use the external devices or the control devices.

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- In the Email function, when the "IP Address" of the "Outgoing mail server (SMTP)" contains "221", the Email will not be sent but the sending result becomes "Successfully Completed". (Only for FT2J/1J models and HG2J/1J models)
- When clearing the Data Log data in the data storage area using any of the following methods, the files (.BIN) saved in the external memory are not deleted.
 - Clear the Data Log data by the Online function of WindO/I-NV4.
 - Clear the Data Log data when the project data is downloaded.
 - Download project data with changed settings of the data storage area or history settings, the system software, or the OS.

<Application Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- > The settings for new features of the System Software are added.
- The following improvements have been made to the "Project Settings" dialog box for FT2J/1J models.
 - "Storage Method of 32-bit Numerical Data for Control Devices" is added to the "Compatible" tab. When a WindO/I-NV3 project in which "Storage Method of 32-bit Numerical Data" is set to "from the Lower word " is opened in WindO/I-NV4, the same setting value can be used in the Control function.
 - In the "Storage Method of 32-bit Numerical Data for Control Devices" of the "System"

tab, the default value was changed to "from Upper word".

- In the "Web Server" tab of the "Project Settings" dialog box, the default values for "Use System Web Page" and "Use Custom Web Page" were changed to disabled. (HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V models, HG4G/3G/2G-5F models, HG2G-5T models, HG1G/1P models)
- EDS file for SX8R-ECBx can be deleted in the EtherNet/IP Setting dialog.

Bugs Fixed

- If you set external device addresses to any of "Start Date and Time", "End Date and Time", or "Date and Time at the center" in "Display of the saved data" on Line Chart X-Axis tab and download, display do not change to the specified date and time even if you change the device address on the external device.
- If you convert a project that contains a Line Chart from WindO/I-NV4 Ver.2.3.0 or later to WindO/I-NV4 Ver.3.1.0, the following situation occurs.
 - When Line Chart and Script Command "Period" are placed on the same screen, the minimum time setting of "Period" does not update correctly.
 - On FT2J/1J or HG2J/1J models, when Line Chart and Alarm Log Display or Data Log Display are placed on the same screen, the dots of "Line Height" do not update correctly.
- For FT2J/1J and HG2J/1J models, if you configure the text ID in Text Manager using Windows font, reopen the project, change the font of the text ID to a font other than Windows font, and then download the project, Registration Text of the parts that use the text ID is not displayed.
- > The following phenomenon occurs in relation to the simulator function
 - If you start a download while starting Simulator, the download fails.
 - If you start the Simulator while the Monitor is running, an error message is displayed when the Monitor is terminated.

WindO/I-NV4 Ver.3.1.0

<Runtime System Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- FT1J, HG1J model is now supported. Following is the unique feature.
 - Displaying 24-bit bitmap images
- > FT2J/1J models and HG2J/1J models now supports the following features.
 - BACnet/IP communication function
 - EtherNet/IP communication function
 - MQTT communication function
 - Expanded device address range for LSM (HMI Special Internal Relay) and LSD (HMI Special Data Register)
 - Communication driver for Emerson ROC Protocol
 - Fixed TCP port numbers 2539 and 2541 for maintenance communication (data transfer)
- > Following improvements were made to the script functions.
 - The trigger condition "Always ON" for global scripts has been integrated into "Period."

- We have smoothed the display of line graphs, ensuring that graphs with slopes now appear more fluid and continuous.

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- For HG2J and FT2J models with OS version 1.1.1, maintenance communication using WindO/I-NV4 cannot be performed in external network environments such as via the Internet.
- When setting Windows font on a Numerical Display or Numerical Input, numbers may not be displayed if the font size is 150 or larger.
- In the FTP client function, even if file transfer is successful, the number of successful file transfers (LSD231) may not increase, and the number of failed file transfers (LSD232) may increase. (Only for HG2J and FT2J models)
- Depending on the USB barcode reader used, uppercase letters in the scanned barcode may not be received. (Only for HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V models and HG4G/3G/2G-5F models)

<Application Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- > The settings for new features of the System Software are added.
- WindO/I-NV3 project file can now be opened with WindO/I-NV4 and change product series to FT1J model.
- Simulator function now supports "WindLDR simulation".
- Changes have been made to improve security for project files.
- The checkbox on the "System" tab of the "Project Settings" dialog box was renamed to "Display the screen after reading the values of the external device addresses" from "Use Device Cache" to make it clearer.

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- When using removable network adapter with a PC, there are instances where it may not connect to the main unit.
- When WindO/I-NV2 project file is converted to WindO/I-NV4 project file, the settings for "SERIAL2" under the "Communication Interface" tab in the "Project Settings" (models: HG2G-S/-5S, HG2G-S/-5S (Ethernet)) should be removed due to changes in the serial interface. However, these settings are copied to "SERIAL1 (RS422/485)" instead.
- When changing only the font in the property dialog box of the Alarm Log Display or Data Log Display on FT2J or HG2J models, the dots of "Line Height" do not update.
- When opening a WAV sound file (.wav) in the "Sound Settings" dialog box, it cannot be opened due to an error if the beginning data of the WAV sound file does not contain fmt information.
- Sometimes, when registering parts from the editing screen to the "Part Library," Picture may fail to be registered.
- In WindO/I-NV4, there are instances where the application may freeze after repeatedly opening and closing the "Project Settings" dialog box dozens of times.

<Web Page Editor>

The following functions have been introduced.

WindO/I-NV4 now supports Web Page Editor Ver.3.7.3. Please check the revision history of Web Page Editor help for the detail.

<Runtime System Software>

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- In the Email Function, when setting two or more addresses in "To" or "Cc", sending an email to Gmail address(es) fails while others succeed.
- In the Email Function, when attaching a log data file by setting "Specify a period of time", the log data for the specified period may not be attached.
- In the Email function, if special characters are included in "Sender Name", "To", "Cc", or "Bcc", sending an e-mail may result in a timeout error or authentication error instead of a parameter error.
- When 32,767 characters or more are set on the "Message" tab of the Message Switching Display without using the Text Manager, messages after the 32,768th character are not displayed correctly.

<Application Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- Improved the representation of a broader set of Vietnamese characters by adopting UTF-8 encoding when the Windows font is set to "Vietnamese".
- Improved the visibility of the WindLDR window when downloading project data to the FT2J model, ensuring it remains visible while accessing the control function.

Bugs Fixed

- When downloading project data using an expansion module with the HG5G model, the warning message "When HG5G-V is used, make sure that the output current amount does not exceed 50 mA." is not displayed.
- When configuring 61,000 or more half-width characters without using the text manager on the "Message" tab of the message switching display, the error message "The total number of registered messages can be up to 61,000 characters." is not displayed.

WindO/I-NV4 Ver.3.0.0

<Runtime System Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- FT2J-7U model is now supported. Following is the unique feature of FT2J-7U.
 - Control function
- The HG2J-7U model now supports the following features.
 - Display the message for initializing clock data
 - Download for ZNX project file saved in an external memory device
- The Social Media function API has been updated for the HG2J-7U model.
- When ending the monitor on WindO/I-NV4, the screen and the values of device addresses are now kept from initializing. (This applies only to HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V models and HG4G/3G/2G-5F models)

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- Emails containing a single quote in the body or subject cannot be sent. (This applies only to the HG2J-7U model)
- For HMI Temporary Registers (LBR) from 130 to 255, the value 0 will not be written in the following scenarios: (This applies only to the HG2J-7U model)
 - When switching screens
 - When changing text groups
 - When changing user accounts
 - When resetting the display screen
- When multiple data are received simultaneously via BACnet communication, the BACnet communication response may become unstable and not recover until the power is turned on again.
- When reading and writing strings from the Custom Web Page, the target string is not converted using the encoding method specified by LSD229. (This applies only to the HG2J-7U model)
- Images registered in Picture Manager may not be displayed if "Vertical (Counter Clockwise)" or "Vertical (Clockwise)" selected as "Installation". (This applies only to the HG2J-7U model)

<Application Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- The settings for new features of the System Software are added.
- > The following improvements have been made to enhance usability.
 - When communicating with HG2J-7U model, the "Download" dialog box now shows the type number and MAC address.

- ZNX project file option has been added for uploading project data when the external memory device is set as the communication target.
- In the "Project Settings" dialog box, under the "Communication Driver" tab and "Communication Driver Network" tab, the following names displayed as external devices have been changed to "Operator Interface".
 - "HG"
 - "MICRO/I"
 - "HMI"

Bugs Fixed

- Download fails if the user selects "Modified Data Only" in the "Download" dialog box and proceeds to download.
- Clicking the "Log in to the Account" button in the "Social Media Account Manager" dialog box of the Social Media function does not display the login screen.
- Right after saving the project from the "Change Product Series" dialog box and going through the "Save Converted Project" dialog box, unnecessary data gets included, causing a temporary increase in the file size of the project data.
- When entering device addresses for external devices with IDs 1 to 31, it's not possible to configure by omitting External Device Name.
- When creating an HG2J-7U model external memory project (ZNX project file or ZNV project file), there might be instances where the project data is smaller than the maximum size of 24 megabytes, yet the message "The download data size of the project is over the limit" is displayed.
- When setting the device address without specifying the External Device Name, the following issues occur:
 - When selecting the Allen-Bradley Logix Controllers (Ethernet) driver and setting it on the Y-axis of a line chart, saving the project file results in the deletion of the screen.
 - When setting the "Notify when Message Send Complete" option in the Email function and saving the project file, the device address can not be saved correctly.
- After placing a selector switch or a potentiometer on the screen, following these steps will result in the screen being deleted.
 - 1. Place parts such as Alarm log Display, Data log Display, or Alarm List Display on a screen and then ungroup them.
 - 2. Group the ungrouped components along with the selector switch or the potentiometer.
 - 3. Save the project file and reopen it.
- When opening a WindO/I-NV2 project file or a read-only WindO/I-NV4 project file warning message is displayed. Clicking "Cancel" on the warning message does not close the project window.
- The error message that appears when entering non-existent or unavailable device addresses in the "Individual Settings" dialog box of the File Transfer function is not accurate.

WindO/I-NV4 Ver.2.3.0

<Runtime System Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- The following functions for Line Chart have been introduced.
 - The date and time can be shown on the X-axis.
 - The key buttons are added to the Line Chart for the scroll.
 - The cursor can be moved to the position where the screen is touched.
 - The position of scale and data for both the X-axis and Y-axis can be displayed inward or outward.
- > The following functions for the Web Server Function have been introduced.
 - The screen of MICRO/I can be switched on the remote monitoring page and remote control page
 - The Custom Web Page can now be viewed from the System Web Page
- LSM (HMI Special Internal Relay) and LSD (HMI Special Data Register) support the functions below.

Bugs Fixed

- In the Message Display and Message Switching Display, some of the parts are displayed when the following conditions are satisfied.
 - The part's "Trigger Condition" is not satisfied.
 - "Scroll" is enabled.
- For the parts that can set Text ID using Text Manager, if both of the following conditions are satisfied, the overlapped text is displayed.
 - The "Use Text Manager" checkbox is ON and Windows font is set on the Text ID.
 - Multiple lines of text are set and the first line is line feed only.
- In the following functions, when a file is repeatedly outputted in a short period, they may output a log with a setting that is different from the setting of "Add Time Stamp".
 - Alarm Log Function
 - Data Log Function
 - Operation Log Function
- The Modbus RTU Slave communication driver does not retry upon encountering a communication error if "Slave Number" is set to 128 or more.
- In the Web Server Function, downloading a project in which "Remote Control and Monitoring" is disabled while the remote monitoring page is open, the screen can be

seen from the remote monitoring page unless the page is reloaded in the browser.

- In the Web Server Function, Japanese strings on the remote control page may be displayed as English strings.
- In user communication, the data may not be transmitted if the following conditions are satisfied.
 - Multiple commands with the same Trigger Condition and "TXD" Type are set.
 - The Trigger Conditions of those commands are satisfied.
- In the E-mail Function, when sending E-mails to an "E-mail Group" that meets the following conditions, the E-mails may not be sent to the E-mail Addresses that are included in the group.
 - 5 or more E-mail Addresses are included.
 - The included E-mail Addresses use "Reference Device Address"
- When the Message Switching Display satisfies the following conditions, MICRO/I may restart.
 - "Scroll" is enabled.
 - Windows font is used in the message.
 - Switch the message to the number that text is not registered.
- BACnet communication may fail to find MICRO/I from other IP subnets.
- In BACnet communication, when LSM70 is turned on I-Am and COV notification sent by COVU function are sent to the wrong destination port.
- In BACnet communications, if the COV and COVU functions are used to continue sending COV notifications at a high frequency, BACnet communications may stop and not recover until the power cycling.
- Undefined error 5 may occur in BACnet communication when "Send Unsubscribed COV" is enabled.
- MICRO/I may restart when the subnet mask of the Ethernet port is from 255.255.255.128 to 255.255.255.254 and "Send Unsubscribed COV" of BACnet object is enabled.

<Application Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- > The settings for new features of the System Software are added.
- Added Text ID search function. You can search for settings where the ID of "Text Manager" is used in the project and move to the corresponding location.
- Added "Text Manager" as a target of the font replacement function.
- License authentication of "Kanji Dictionary Data" is now available for HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V models in a project.
- Added group parts similar to "Selector Switch" and "Potentiometer" to the "Sample Library" of the "Parts Library".
- Improved a phenomenon where, when Shibaura-Machine is selected for the "Communication Driver," an invalid device address could be set.
- The shapes in the "View" tab of a part are no longer hidden when the created project file is opened with an older version.

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- If the name of the project file is changed on Windows and is used for the "Reuse screens", the list of screens is not displayed and cannot be reused.
- If the project contains a script, which has "NG" as its "Error" status in "Script Manager", and is used in the "Reuse Screen", WindO/I-NV4 can no longer accept control.
- When the script, added by "Import" in "Script Manager", is used in the project and "Simulator" is executed, the script does not appear in the "Script Debugger".
- When a Character Input and a Message Display are placed on the screen and "Standard F0008" is set on the "View" tab for each, the drawing on WindO/I-NV4 does not match the drawing on the operator interface.
- In the "Properties" dialog box of the Numerical Display, pressing the up arrow for "Digits" allows the user to set a value that exceeds the upper limit for the "Data type". When a project file using this numerical display is downloaded to the operator interface, the operator interface resets continuously.
- If the "Data Type" of the bar chart is changed to "Float32" while the "Origin", "Minimum", and "Maximum" in the "General" tab are set in device addresses, they change to the value.
- When a part with the device address of an external device is copied and pasted to the project file that does not use that external device, the device address of the external device does not get deleted.
- When copying and pasting a part with a script from another project, the script is recognized as an OK script even if it is an NG script. As a result, invalid script downloads can be made to the operator interface.

Bugs Fixed

- The "Download" dialog box cannot be opened when the PC does not have a valid network adapter and one of the following conditions is satisfied.
 - Select "External Memory Device" in the "Communication Settings" dialog box
 - Select "USB" in the "Communication Settings" dialog box

<Runtime System Software>

The following functions have been introduced.

- Message to display on Message Switching Display can be specified by text ID on Text Manager.
- HG2J-7U model supports the following functions.
 - The Data Copy function
 - Switch to System Mode by using RESET switch on the back of the operator interface
 - Line Spacing of the installed fonts
 - The Pass-Through function
 - Default Gateway of Wireless LAN function
 - O/I Link Communication with HG4F/3F/2F/2S/1F

Bugs Fixed

- If you repeatedly open and close the Popup Screens with and without the Data Log Display, the value of the Data Log Display may not display.
- When a Picture Display with the rotation function enabled is placed on the Popup Screen and rotated it out of the display area, the touchscreen may restart.
- In the Line Charts, if the Y-axis label uses Windows fonts and is placed so as to protrude from the component, the touchscreen may restart.
- > In the Data Log Display, a long string displayed in labels may not wrap.
- If you place an NMF (NV Metafile) picture on the Top layer and change to that screen, the touchscreen may restart.
- If you set "Change Display Colors" in the Message Switching Display and turn on "Flush", the text's color becomes light red.
- When the Data log data is output to a CSV file while operating the Data Log Display, blank spaces may be included between values.
- File system time information is not updated when the system's clock is changed using the internal device or system area. This is applicable to HG5G/4G/3G/2G-V.
- In Keyence KV (Ethernet) communication driver, when you put the parts using multiple link relays (B), work relays (VB), and link registers (W) on the same screen, a value may different from the device address specified in.
- SNS Messages may not be sent if the external device address is included in the SNS content.
- If there are items set to "Do not use" in the e-mail function or SNS function, the device address of the connected device to be used may be incorrectly referenced.

 - Align Text Vertical: Center-Top
- In Alarm List Display, the registration text of the buttons are not displayed in proper position in "View" tab.
- In the property dialog box of Alarm List Display and Alarm Log Display, if "Browse" button in "View" tab is pressed, and a Fixed Flange object is selected in "View Browser", the width of flange in Editing Window is wider than proper width.
- In Alarm List Display and Alarm Log Display, the setting of "Style" in "Format" tab is reflected to the registration text of the buttons in "View" tab and "View Browser".
- In the property dialog box of Alarm Log Display, even if a text which is registered in "Text Manager" is assigned to the "Title" in "Log" tab, the setting of "Style" in "Format" tab is not reflected to the title text of Alarm Log Display in Editing Window.
- In the property dialog box of Alarm Log Display, the height of background of messages in Editing Window is different from the display image on MICRO/I when "Reverse" check box in "Format" tab is ON.
- In "Format" tab on the property dialog box of Alarm List Display and Alarm Log Display, if other than 1 is selected as "Magnification H", and then the same part object is created on the screen, the message area of the new object is not displayed properly.
- In "Format" tab on the property dialog box of Alarm Log Display, if other than 1 is selected as "Magnification H", the following problems occur.
 - In Editing Window, messages on Alarm Log Display are not displayed properly
 - In Editing Window, the coordinate of messages and Lines on Alarm Log Display is not the same as the MICRO/I
- Even if base screens and popup screens are reopened, "Undo" and "Redo" work.
- If following items are changed from context menu, the result is not displayed correctly, and "Undo" does not work.
 - "Line Width"
 - "Line Type"
 - "Color" "Foreground Color", "Background Color", "Text Color", "Text Background Color", "Shadow Color"
 - "Size" "Make Same Width", "Make Same Height"
- In Editing Window, when more than one drawing object and part object is moved, the rectangles which indicate the objects are not displayed properly.
- In Line of drawing object, if the coordinate of X or Y is configured from "Format" tab in Ribbon and the value is greater than the Editing Window, the configuration is not applied.
- Drawing objects and part objects which are bigger than the base screen size cannot be resized in Editing Window.
- > The context menu which is displayed when drawing objects or part objects are not

selected appears when the dot line which indicates the popup screen in the base screen is selected and left mouse button is clicked.

- A part of the rectangle is not displayed properly while the Rectangle of drawing object is resizing in Editing Window.
- If the following drawing objects are located outside of Editing Window, scroll bar is not displayed.
 - "Point 1" of Line
 - Fill
- If Line and other drawing objects are selected and moved to the side of Editing Window, the positional relationship between those drawing objects is changed.
- If more than one drawing object and part object is selected and "Send to Back" is executed, the order of the selected objects is reversed.
- If Reshape mode of Poly Line or Polygon is terminated by "ESC" key, and then "Line" on "Home" tab is clicked, unexpected line is drawn from the End Point of PolyLine or Polygon to the top left corner of Editing Window.
- The following items are not displayed properly when the part object is placed outside of the base screen or popup screen.
 - Part Name
 - Device Address
 - Trigger Condition
 - Security Group
- Grid setting is not applied when moving or resizing the dot line of the popup screen.
- If Reshape mode of Poly Line or Polygon is terminated by "ESC" key, and then Poly Line or Polygon is selected in Toolbox and the drawing object is drawn, unexpected line is drawn from the top left corner of Editing Window to the Start Point of the drawing object.
- The Rectangle of drawing object which contains the following settings is not displayed in Editing Window.
 - "Curve" is selected as "Round Type"
 - "1" is entered as "Round Radios"
 - "Convex" or "Concave" is selected as "Shadow"
- "Display" and "Input" check box on "View" tab in Ribbon may become active even if screens are not opened.
- If Line of drawing object and other drawing object or Part object is selected and "Align" is executed, the function may not work properly.
- In Editing Window, even if "Snap to Grid" is enabled, a drawing object may not be snapped to the grid when it is resized.
- If the WindO/I-NV2 project name is changed without WindO/I-NV2, and then the project is opened by WindO/I-NV4, the settings on "Communication Driver Network" tab in "Project Settings" dialog box is deleted.
- The picture which satisfies the following conditions is not displayed as X sign after downloading the project to the MICRO/I if the project is originally created by WindO/I-NV2 and opened by WindO/I-NV4.
 - NV Metafile
 - The picture is stored into External Memory

- If the WindO/I-NV2 project contains Text of drawing object and "Use Text Area" is OFF, the size of Text is increased by 1 dot after the project is opened by WindO/I-NV4.
- If the WindO/I-NV2 project contains Multi-state Lamp and it satisfies the following conditions, linefeeds are removed when the project is opened by WindO/I-NV4.
 - "Windows" is selected as "Font" in "Registration Text" tab
 - Registration Text contains linefeeds
- If "Active User" is registered in Quick Access Tool Bar and "OK" button is pressed in "Open Screens" dialog box when opening a project, the following message appears.
 "WindO/I-NV4 cannot read this file.

This is not a valid file, or its format is not a project file."

- When "Arrange" or "Size" is added to Quick Access Tool Bar and "Coordinates" or "Size" of Drawing objects or Part objects is changed by those "Arrange" or "Size", the display image on Editing Window is not changed.
- ▶ When "Arrange" is added to Quick Access Tool Bar and set the focus to "X" or "Y" of the "Arrange", "Align" and "Rotate" cannot be used from the "Arrange".
- If the text box of "State" in "View" tab is added to Quick Access Tool Bar, and then Multistate Lamp, Message Switching Display or Picture Display is placed on Editing Window, WindO/I-NV4 crash.
- If the text box for changing screen in "Online" tab is added to Quick Access Tool Bar, and enter invalid character while monitoring, WindO/I-NV4 crash.
- Label text in Ribbon can be added to Quick Access Tool Bar.
- The icon which is registered on Quick Access Tool Bar is not masked when project is not opened.
- Even if Text Group is changed, "Text Group" in Quick Access Tool Bar is not updated.
- When "Emerson RCO Protocol" is selected as Communication Driver and a Device Address of TLP device format is selected as "Source" on "General" tab in "Individual Settings" dialog box of "Data Log Settings" dialog box, the project cannot be opened.
- When reopening the project, "O/I Link Station" on "O/I Link" tab in "Project Settings" is change back to the default.

Bugs Fixed

The following problems have been fixed:

- If more than one Communication Driver is configured, MICRO/I may be reset when an indirect read is executed to a non-existent Device Address in the external device.
- In Line Chart, when the date and time data at the position indicated by the cursor is displayed with 7-Segment font, it is not displayed correctly.

The following functions have been introduced.

- Color Palette or Pattern Palette is displayed when other area than the down triangle symbol on color selection button or pattern selection button is clicked.

"Serial Interface" may be changed to "RS422/485 2-wire".

- Change Product Series does not work when project name contains period.
- While changing product series, if "Cancel" button is clicked on "Save As" dialog box, changing product series is canceled, but "Installation" is changed.
- > Project may not be uploaded if picture exists in "Picture Manager" of the project.
- If base screens or popup screens are reused with "Reuse Screen" from project whose "Installation" is different, size of reused screens becomes invalid.
- For Line Chart, if "Chart Type" is "Device Address Display" and "Reference Device Address" is Device Address of External Device, the Line Chart does not work on MICRO/I correctly.
- If WindO/I-NV2 project contains Message Display and its "Change Color by Device" is enabled, this Message Display does not work after the project is opened and then downloaded with WindO/I-NV4.
- If picture files are imported in WindO/I-NV2 project with "Import with color conversion" enabled, these picture files may be displayed incorrectly after the project is opened with WindO/I-NV4.
- Image of imported picture file in "Picture Manager" may become incorrect when format of the picture file is following.
 - ICO file
 - WMF file
- When WMF file is imported in "Picture Manager", the size of the imported picture file is not proper.
- Even if duplicated "Text ID" is found when "Copy", "Cut", "Paste", or "Reuse Screen" is used, confirmation message for overwriting "Text ID" is not displayed.
- Even if "Text Align" in "Format" tab is changed in property dialog box, the modification may not be reflected when multiple Numerical Inputs or Numerical Displays are selected.
- Even if "With Unit" in "Format" tab is changed in property dialog box, the modification may not be reflected in Editing Window when multiple Numerical Inputs or Numerical Displays are selected.
- For Numerical Input and Numerical Display, if numerical value is set as unit, its preview is not correctly displayed in Editing Window.
- WindO/I-NV2 project cannot be opened when NV Metafile which contains Circle/Ellipse or Arc is imported in "Picture Manager".
- For Numerical Input, Character Input, Message Display, Message Switching Display, Numerical Display, and Calendar, property dialog box cannot be closed with "OK" button if all following conditions are satisfied.
 - "Image Type" is "None".
 - The last item in "Object List" is a button.
- If O/I Link Slave is configured in "Project Settings" dialog box, error message is displayed and the dialog box cannot be closed.
- If Multi-Button is arranged, following problems may happen.
 - If "Bit Write" is set as second or later item in "Function List", and "Destination Device Address" is a Device Address of External Device, the Bit Write does not work correctly.
 - If "Word Write" is set as second or later item in "Function List", "Transfer" and "Write" become default after reopening project.

- If "Reuse Screen" is used, the following problems may happen.
 - Device Addresses and "Trigger Condition" in the duplicated screens are deleted.
 - "NG" is displayed on "Error" column in "Script Manager"
- If "Not Display Image" is ON in Pilot Lamp, following problems happen.
 - If the screen which contains this Pilot Lamp is reused with "Reuse Screen", the screens may not be displayed correctly.
 - This Pilot Lamp cannot be pasted to another WindO/I-NV4 screen.
- When multiple screens are reused with "Reuse Screen", following problems happen if the same picture is used in more than one screen.
 - the reused screens may not be displayed
 - the picture in the reused screens is not correct
- When multiple screens are reused with "Reuse Screen", setting of Script Manager may become incorrect if the same script ID is used in more than one screen.
- > Security setting may become incorrect if downloading or uploading is aborted.
- > Project may not be saved correctly if Bit Number of LKR (HMI Keep Register) is used.
- For Message Switching Display and Keypad, if all following conditions are satisfied, the screen which contains the part object is deleted.
 - "Stroke" is selected as "Font"
 - Message is set in "Message" tab (For Message Switching Display only)

 - If those Device Addresses are used in script, the Device Addresses are not deleted even if the address is greater than the maximum address.

 - The Device Address can be read, but cannot be written by MICRO/I in the Communication Driver which is configured after changing
- When changing Communication Driver, a part of scripts is removed.
- If the security group which is assigned to a part object does not exist and "Undo" or "Redo" is executed, security setting becomes invalid and the following problem may

happen.

- The property dialog box of part object cannot be closed
- WindO/I-NV4 may freeze if you edit Security Group setting
- If you operate the following steps, the event names are not described in Operation log file in External Memory.
 - 1. Create a new project
 - 2. Disable Operation Log function and save the project
 - 3. Reopen the project and enable Operation Log function
 - 4. Download the project to the MICRO/I
- The downloaded recipe file name in External Memory is not proper. The default file name is used instead of the setting file name on "Block" tab in "Recipe Setting" dialog box.
- In Protocol 2 through 7, if "User Communication" is selected as "Function", the same Device Address of Protocol 1 is displayed in "Change IP Address and Port Number by Device Address".
- If "Windows" is selected as "Font" for Text ID1 of Text Group1 in Text Manager, and "Bold Italic" is selected as "Style" of the Windows font, the "Style" setting is changed to "Regular" after reopening Text Manager.
- In Message Switching Display, "Text Color" and "Plate Color" on "Message" tab are not reflected to the display image on Editing Window.

(This defect only happens in Japanese and Chinese Edition.)

- Project cannot be saved when the following conditions are satisfied.
 - The opened screen contains grouped objects or drawings
 - The state of "Handle Logical operations as Bit operations" on "Compatible" tab in "Project Settings" dialog box is changed.
- In Message Switching Display, If "Value" is selected as "Switching Method" in "General" tab, the following defects are caused.
 - If the value of "State" on "Screen" group in "View" tab of Ribbon is greater than 15 and "Switching Method" is changed to "Bit Number", the property dialog box of the Message Switching Display cannot be closed.
 - Even if the order of the message is changed in "Message" tab, it is not reflected to the display image of the Message Switching Display on Editing Window.
- when the value of "State" on "Screen" group in "View" tab of Ribbon is not zero, the following objects cannot be displayed as proper state.
 - Duplicated Message Switching Display, Multistate Lamp and Picture Display
 - Pasted Message Switching Display
- If you copy an object and paste it to another WindO/I-NV4, the Device Address of HMI Keep Relay(LK) and HMI Keep Register(LKR) which is greater than the settings in "Data Storage Area Management" dialog box can be assigned.
- The latest modification is not restored from backup project which can be opened from "Project Recovery" dialog box.
- Script Error may happen if "Handle Logical operations as Bit operations" on "Compatible" tab in "Project Settings" dialog box is ON.
- Even if "Handle Logical operations as Bit operations" on "Compatible" tab in "Project Settings" dialog box is changed, the setting is not reflected to "Trigger Condition".
- > The selected Text color in "Format" tab is displayed as the Text color of Message

Switching Display instead of the Text color of "Msg0" when reopen the project.

- In Message Switching Display, if "Use Text Manager" check box is ON and the parameter of "Change" column is changed from "Y" to "blank", the entered message is deleted.
- ▶ If "Windows" is selected as "Font" in property of Text, the following problems happen.
 - If "Bold" is selected as "Style", it is changed to "Regular" after reopening the project.
 - If "Bold Italic" is selected as "Style", it is changed to "Bold" after reopening the project.
- If two WindO/I-NV4s are launched and different Communication Drivers are assigned, and then Multi Button, Multi Command or Script Command is copied and pasted each other, Device Addresses in the script which is assigned to the object may be deleted.
- ▶ If entered Tag Name or comment in Tag Editor contains vertical bar(|), it is deleted.
- In script or Trigger Condition, if used Device Address is Hexadecimal, MICRO/I access to incorrect Device Address.

 - Paste base screen or popup screen on "Project" tab in "Workspace"
 - Add a new list in "Registration Monitor"
- ▶ If "Save Auto Recover information every" is enabled, the following problems happen.
 - The modification of the project is not reflected after downloading the project.
 - Confirmation message for saving project is not displayed even if the project is modified.
- If Emerson ROC Protocol is selected and TLP type format is used as Device Address, MICRO/I accesses to incorrect Device Address.
- If "@" is used in Tag Name and the Tag Name is used in script, unexpected error message is displayed.
- If an existing project is opened, "Auto Resize" function does not work even if the "Auto Resize" button is enabled.
- Even if the property of Popup screen is changed, it may not be reflected to the dotted rectangle which is displayed when "Popup Screen" on "Show/Hide" group in "View" tab is ON.
- The folder path which contains a dot character cannot be specified as "Default file Location" on "Save" tab in "WindO/I-NV4 Options" dialog box
- Even if the Device Address do not exist in the project, it can be set in part object after Undo/Redo is executed.

- If Emerson ROC Protocol is selected as Communication Driver, the Parameters which has unsupported data type of TIME are shown on Tag Editor dialog box.
- If the following conditions are satisfied, the project cannot be opened properly.
 - "Windows" is selected as "Font" in Multi-State Lamp
 - The project is created by WindO/I-NV2(*.n2g)
