T1 International Precinct

We'll progressively expand the T1 International Precinct to meet demand. Upgrades will include terminal extensions, improved passenger processing, and enhanced baggage systems – all aimed at boosting capacity, flexibility and improving the experience for passengers.

Integrated Terminal

To meet growing demand over the next 20 years, we're planning a major expansion of the T2/T3 terminal precinct — creating a new Integrated Terminal that will make it easier than ever to move between regional, domestic and international flights. This upgrade will deliver improved comfort, efficiency and flexibility for millions of passengers each year, while expanding our capacity to handle more flights, more destinations and a greater variety of aircraft. It builds on our current \$200 million T2 Domestic upgrade, which improves the airport experience for millions of travellers each year with faster check-ins, enhanced security, and better facilities.
