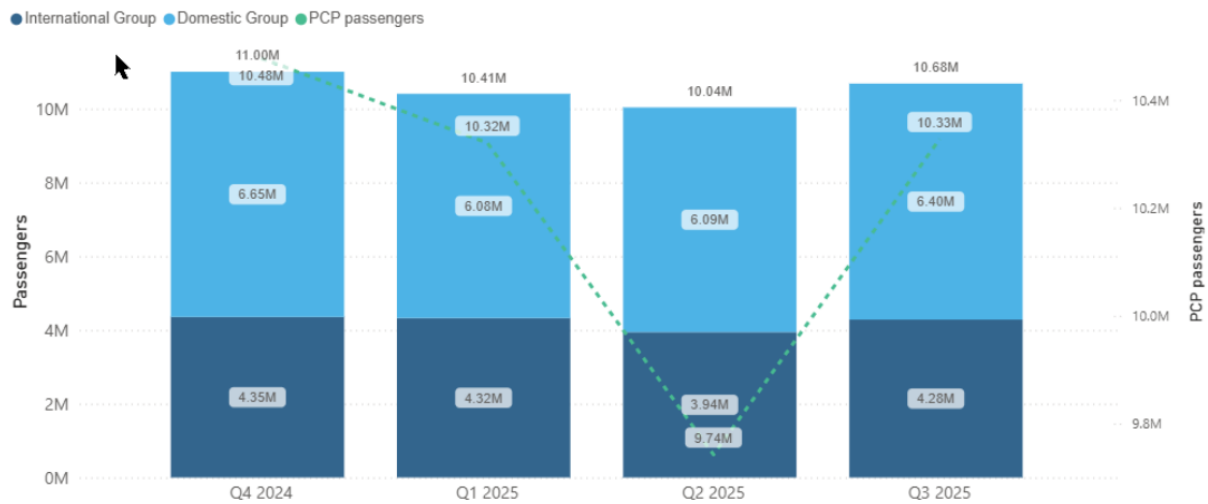

All data has been rounded to the nearest thousand and in some instances the total may not be equal to the sum of the parts. Percentage changes have been calculated based on actual figures.
4. The percentage of flights which departed within 0-15 mins of the scheduled off block time. First departure for the day before 9am
5. The airside movement of an aircraft from the moment it touches down on the runway to arriving at the boarding gate.
6. The time it takes for 90% of passengers to clear immigration after they disembark from their flight.
