Located 8 km from Sydney's CBD, we are Australia's international gateway – connecting the city to more than 100 destinations across the country and the world.

\$70.6 billion

Our annual contribution to the Australian Economy by 2045, up 56% from today.

1,500 jobs created every year

Over the next 20-years, full-time job numbers will increase to 105,600, meaning around 1,500 new jobs will be created every year, mostly benefitting the local community.

\$329 million

Contribution to the economy from a single international A380 service — supporting 2,100 jobs.

GDP (Gross Domestic Product) is the country's total yearly income.

1.4 million annual tonnes

Airfreight handled by 2045, up 133% on today.

204,200 new jobs by 2045

Including tourism and freight industries. The number of jobs will increase from 354,800 to 559,000 in 2045.
