The following revision is being made to the 2021 Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage Plan Evidence of Coverage (EOC).

Hearing Aid Coverage

We have revised the language to reflect the hearing aid allowance is one allowance for both ears.

<p>Hearing aid coverage*</p> <p>We cover the hearing aid services listed below (including, fitting, counseling, adjustment, cleaning, and inspection) when prescribed by a plan provider (clinical audiologist).</p> <p>We provide an allowance that you can use toward the purchase of hearing aid(s) every 36 months. If two aids are required to provide significant improvement that is not obtainable with only one hearing aid, we will cover one hearing aid for each ear. The allowance may only be used once in any 36-month period. If you do not use all of the allowance at the initial point of sale, you cannot use it later.</p> <p>We select the provider or vendor that will furnish the covered hearing aid. Coverage is limited to the types and models of hearing aids furnished by the provider or vendor.</p>	<p>\$1,000 allowance for hearing aid(s). If the hearing aid(s) you purchase costs more than \$1,000, you pay the difference.</p>
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
