

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: OCTOBER COLLEAGUE CO-OP LIVE DREAMSEATS MONTHLY PRIZE DRAW

- 1. PROMOTER:** This promotion is operated by Co-operative Group Limited, a registered society under the Co-operative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014, Registered No 525R with registered office at 1 Angel Square, Manchester, M60 0AG. References to "we", "us" or "our" in these terms and conditions are references to the promoter.
- 2. OPENING AND CLOSING DATE:** This promotion opens at **00:01 on 1st OCTOBER 2025** and closes at **23:59 on 25th OCTOBER 2025** (the 'Promotional Period'). Any entries made before the opening date or after the closing date will not be valid and will not be eligible for this promotion.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY:** This promotion is open to residents of the United Kingdom who are colleague members of the Co-operative Group only. Entrants must be over 16 at the date at which they enter the promotion. If you are under 18 years old, you represent and warrant to us by entering this prize draw that your parents/guardians have consented to your entry and to these Terms and Conditions, which they have read. Employees from Co-op group undertakings and employees of its agencies directly connected with the creation and administration of this promotion are not eligible to enter. We may ask the winners to provide proof of age and/or identity.

- 5. PRIZES:** There are **60 prizes** to be won. Each Prize is for 2 tickets for selected concerts or comedy acts at Co-op Live in Manchester (subject to availability) **held in December 2025**. Maximum one pair of tickets per winner. There are a limited number of tickets per show. Winners will be given a choice of shows to attend, subject to availability. Tickets will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. We may substitute or change the prizes for a prize of an equivalent or greater value if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to do so but there will be no cash alternative.
