


ACTIVITY PACK












BANANA BREAD RECIPE

Make your own soft and tasty banana bread at home with this quick and easy recipe.







Cook Time: 1hr 30m





115g Butter 1tsp Bicarbonate of soda 225g Self raising flour 75g Dark brown sugar 2 Eggs 3 Very ripe bananas 30ml Milk

METHOD

- Preheat oven to 160C and grease and line a 900g loaf tin
- 2 In a large bowl cream the butter and sugar until it is fluffy
- 3 Add the eggs and mix well
- **4** Sift in the bicarb and flour, mix thoroughly
- **5** Peel and mash the bananas in a bowl
- 6 Add the milk and continue to mash
- 7 Mix the bananas into the cake batter till the batter is soft, smooth and glossy
- 8 Pour the mix into your lined tin and bake in the oven for 1hr 1hr 30 or till cooked through
